

Arrive Cochin at 08:45. Transfer to Brunton boat yard. Afternoon sunset cruise on the Harbour. Dinner

Day 4: Thursday 19 February 2026

Board MV Vaikundam - drive from Cochin to Alleppey to board MV Vaikundam

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Alleppey / Punnamada / Kanjipaddom

Board RV Vaikundam this afternoon at Punnamada in Alleppey. Our welcoming team on-board will help you with smooth check-in, followed

by the safety briefing.

Enjoy the traditional lunch and relax on-board.

Our guide on-board will brief us about Alleppey – the Green Venice of the East, its



geographical, cultural and social significance.

We will drop anchor at Kanjippadom, where we will explore the village on a leisurely walk. We will also visit the boat building yard.

Day 5: Friday

20 February 2026

Kanjippadom – Karumadi – Thottappalli

Overnight onboard MV Vaikundam. Breakfast, lunch, Dinner

Day 6: Saturday 21 February 2026

Thottappalli – Changankari

While cruising, we will have an informative lecture by an Ayurveda doctor to know about this 5000-years old Science of life. We will reach the remote village Changankari and drop our anchors.

Day 7: Sunday

22 February 2026

Changankari - Champakkulam -

Mankompu

Traditional lunch at a beautiful house of a local family, on the bank of the Pampa River. Cruise to Mankompu village where we will witness a cultural performance.

Overnight onboard MV Vaikundam. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8: Monday

23 February 2026

Mankompu – Kainakari – Kavalam

We will take the country boat to travel through the more narrow canals, observing local life along the way.

Return to the boat. Lunch onboard, while cruising to Kavalam, where the river reverses its course and drains into Lake Vembanad. As we go along the way we interact with toddy tappers.

Overnight onboard MV Vaikundam. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 9: Tuesday

24 February 2026

Kavalam - Kumarakom

Early this morning, we set out by country boat to watch the migratory birds of Kumarakom. This afternoon, we will visit the house of a Syrian Christian family for a home hosted lunch. Return to our boat and cruise to Thanneermukkom barrage, built across Vembanad, the largest lake of Kerala, divides the lake into two; one half with perennial salty water and the other with fresh water enriched by rivers.

Overnight onboard MV Vaikundam. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 10: Wednesday

25 February 2026

Kumarakom - Chenganda - Vaikom

After breakfast we sail to Chenganda village where we will get an opportunity to interact with coir weavers, the shell harvesters and farmers. Return to the boat for lunch while

sailing. We drop the anchor at the ancient village, Vaikom. We will have a short walk to

visit the cultural centre to watch Kathakali. We will take a tuk tuk ride to the ancient temple of Shiva. farewell dinner on board. Overnight onboard MV Vaikundam. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 11: Thursday 26 February 2026

We will sail from Vaikom towards the jetty for Marari Beach. Short drive to Seclude Marari Sands for three nights beach stay. Breakfast, Dinner.



Day 12: Friday

27 February

Day at leisure at Seclude Marari Sands. Breakfast, Dinner

28 February
