a group called the Greenwood Cemetery Association was formed

organizing the Palmyra Cemetery. On the Palmyra Greenwood Cemetery website one can learn more about the recently added columbarium and cemetery services, view a map, and locate a grave. Greenwood Cemetery has begun a multi-year restoration project, working on both Greenwood and Palmyra Cemeteries, the latter of which has stones dating back to the 1800s and in need of the most attention. Donations to assist in this endeavor are welcome and appreciated. Greenwood Cemetery also maintains a Facebook page to keep the local community up to date with what the cemetery is doing and offer another point of contact.







Two ribbon cuttings were held to celebrate two new Main Street businesses.


