

City of Greenfield - City Council Meeting Minutes – July 14, 2026

Mayor Fox called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All members of the Council were present.

Consent Agenda

Clayton moved, seconded by Faust, to approve the agenda, the June 23, 2026, meeting minutes, and the claims. Motion carried.

Clayton moved, seconded by Christensen, to approve the temporary closure of NE Elm Street between NE 3rd Street and NE 2nd Street for a Greenfield Pool event on Friday, July 17, 2026. Motion carried.

McMorran moved, seconded by Faust, to approve Resolution 2026-29, designating the official physical and online public notice posting locations for City Council meetings and establishing standard posting locations for City boards, commissions, and committees. As a result, the City's official website will be added as an official location for posting agendas and minutes. Motion carried.

Eble moved, seconded by McMorran, to approve Resolution 2026-30, approving the Greenfield Volunteer Fire Department Membership By-Laws and Oversight Structure. Motion carried.

Eble moved, seconded by Christensen, to approve Pay Application No. 11 from Graphite Construction Group for the Greenfield Fire Station project in the amount of \$119,037.97. Motion carried.

Clayton moved, seconded by McMorran, to approve Pay Application No. 1 and final from Sacket Construction for west-side paving at the Greenfield Fire Station in the amount of \$62,960. Motion carried.

Department Reports

A summary of the Library's year-end report was shared.

Community Development reported that the community welcome signs are showing wear and may need to be repaired or replaced. The department will research potential grant funding.

Public Works reported that Municipal Pipe Tool continues to make good progress on the sewer rehabilitation project.

The Police Department reported that Coffee with Cops will be held Saturday, July 25, 2026, at Hotel Greenfield.

The Fire Department and Community Development will begin planning a grand opening for the fire station in fall 2026.
