

Unplug

Severson Dells connects people to nature through education and research and has focused on this mission since 1976. Staff and volunteers over the years have provided high-quality programs for all ages that inspire a love for nature in an ever-changing world. For better or worse, technology has become an increasingly large part of our lives over the past two decades. This has changed the way people learn and also how they interact with others and the environment.

In 2018, Severson Dells' theme "Unplug to Connect" encouraged people to put down their screens and connect with nature, friends and family. In the era of Nature Deficit Disorder, this quality screen-free time has become increasingly important and seemingly harder to do. There is a growing body of research of the mental, physical and emotional health benefits of spending time in nature. People are becoming increasingly aware of these benefits and are seeking more and more nature and health-related programs. While we don't expect people to completely unplug, we do hope they will enjoy their time in nature for the sake of being in nature and not just for the photo opportunity. After attending our annual breakfast, the theme "Unplug to Connect" hit a cord with Winnebago County Chairman, Frank Haney, who then approached us with the idea of a larger county-wide initiative of Unplug 815 to encourage residents to get outside and visit the many green spaces in Winnebago County. This was the impetus for what is now 815 Outside, a collaboration of nature organizations in Winnebago County that includes the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County, the Natural Land Institute, Nature at the Confluence, Klehm Arboretum, Rockford Park District and Severson Dells Nature Center. The land at Severson Dells has inspired so many to fall in love with nature. Whether strolling through the woods, wading in the creek or wandering the prairie, you can't help the inevitable connection. With all that this place gives, we wanted to give back to the land.

Habitat restoration has been occurring in various forms for a number of years at Severson Dells. The Forest Preserve has maintained the property for almost forty-five years. To help support them, Nature Center staff and volunteers have taken on a variety of restoration projects over the years.

In 2018, with the generous support of the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation, Severson Dells was able to support habitat restoration on a whole new level. A number of items were purchased to support volunteer restoration work and the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County habitat restoration plan, including trees for the oak savanna restoration, hand tools and seed collection bags, and additional tools to monitor the success of restoration and citizen science efforts.

This funding from the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation is a 3-to-1 matching grant with additional financial support available when 400 volunteer hours are reached. The unique nature of this grant allowed Severson Dells to involve the community in restoration projects over the course of the year, both as financial supporters and as on-the-ground volunteers. For every dollar we raised in support of habitat restoration, the Foundation awarded us three dollars. Once we reached 400 volunteer hours, the Foundation awarded us an additional \$4,000 for habitat restoration. Staff chose two very different areas to focus our efforts. The first was inside the paved loop, an area most-frequented by visitors, and used by staff and for school field trips. We want this area to reflect what a healthy oak woodland should look like, and we are very aware that significant work is needed for this to happen. This area is overrun by invasive honey-suckle and garlic mustard. By the end of 2018, volunteers removed a majority of the honeysuckle from inside the paved loop and the remaining stems should be gone by the end of 2019. This is just the first step in restoring the loop to be the quality habitat we know it can be, so we can use it more effectively as a teaching tool.

The second area was a 3-acre patch of upland habitat above the creek on the way to the dells. This site was chosen because it is located in the Illinois State Nature Preserve, a state protection designated because of the quality and ecological importance of the habitat. Garlic mustard has encroached on the site, and in order to keep the quality habitat of the nature preserve, we thought it was important to dedicate effort to maintain the area.

We are so grateful to all those who support this project either through volunteer efforts or financial support. Through their generosity we have made a significant ecological impact and raised \$21,000 for restoration and suppies at Severson Dells. Thank you and we look forward to continuing habitat restoration to provide the highest quality habitat and the best natural learning area possible.

SEVERSON DELLS EDUCATION FOUNDATION

When Fannie Severson donated 369-acres to the Winnebago County Forest Preserve District, she dreamed of having a nature center in the family's "Deer Lodge." 
