



CLERGY MESSAGE

Rev. Mr. Thomas Boyle - Deacon



The Holy Spirit dwells with us and teaches us the wisdom of God from age to age. Saint Andre' Bessette, a Holy Cross brother from Montreal, once said, "Put yourself in God's hands: he abandons no one." This is what the Spirit means for us. We are forever accompanied by the power and presence of God, who showers us with his gifts so that we can be converted and convert others in turn. Just as God never abandons us, so we must never abandon others in fidelity to his Spirit.

The Christian life, the road we walk when we turn away from sin and are faithful to the gospel, is always uncharted territory. The Holy Spirit is our compass and our guide. When we lose our way, it is the Spirit that gently guides us back to Christ and his church. It is the quiet but potent voice that whispers within us, reminding us of our origins and our destiny in Christ. Seeking forgiveness is often the first step in learning how to become a child of God more fully. Once freed of our obstacles to God and his work, we can see the way forward with greater ability and stronger resolve, both of which are from God. The Spirit of truth, which leads us and teaches us, is also the strength that helps us to walk toward Christ our goal!


Programa de la Imagen de la Virgen Peregrina


