## THIS WEEK: REV. MR. TOM BOYLE — PERMANENT DEACON





We come to know God through forgiveness. Today's first reading from Jeremiah tells of God's covenant with the house of Israel. God assures the people that they will no longer have to teach their friends and relatives how to know the Lord. That relationship, God says, is built through mercy. "All, from least to greatest, shall know me, says the Lord, for I will forgive their evil doing and remember their sin no more. "In these waning days of Lent, we too are called to open our hearts to God's forgiveness.

Jeremiah tells of God's decision to "place my law within (the people) and write it upon their hearts" during a time of deep despair. The prophet wrote at the beginning of the sixth century BC, when the Israelites carried great anxiety over the looming fall of Jerusalem and Babylonian exile. It seemed their God was nowhere to be found in the face of such suffering. Yet Jeremiah insists "the days are coming" when God will breathe new life into the people. God will not just write the new covenant in stone, but rather on the very hearts of people. Here God will make an intimate promise: "I will be their God, and they shall be my people."

Now is the time to remember the new covenant etched in our hearts through the waters of baptism and affirmed in the Eucharist. Christ Jesus, through his suffering, death, and resurrection, draws us into the hope of eternal life.

Llegamos a conocer a Dios a través del perdón. La primera lectura de hoy de Jeremías habla del pacto de Dios con la casa de Israel. Dios asegura a la gente que ya no tendrán que enseñar a sus amigos y parientes cómo conocer al Señor. Esa relación, dice Dios, se construye a través de la misericordia. "Todos, de menor a mayor, me conocerán, dice el Señor, porque perdonaré su maldad y no recordaré más su pecado. "En estos últimos días de Cuaresma, también nosotros estamos llamados a abrir nuestros corazones al perdón de Dios.

Jeremías habla de la decisión de Dios de "poner mi ley dentro (el pueblo) y escribirla en sus corazones" durante un tiempo de profunda desesperación. El profeta escribió a principios del siglo VI aC, cuando los israelitas llevaron gran ansiedad por la inminente caída de Jerusalén y el exilio babilónico. Parecía que su Dios no se encontraba en ninguna parte ante tal sufrimiento. Sin embargo, Jeremías insiste en que "los días están llegando" cuando Dios dará nueva vida a la gente. Dios no solo escribirá el nuevo pacto en piedra, sino más bien en los corazones de la gente. Aquí Dios hará una promesa íntima: "Yo seré su Dios, y ellos serán mi pueblo."

Ahora es el momento de recordar el nuevo pacto grabado en nuestros corazones a través de las aguas del bautismo y afirmado en la Eucaristía. Cristo Jesús, a través de su sufrimiento, muerte y resurrección, nos lleva a la esperanza de la vida eterna.



# St. Patrick's Breastplate Prayer

Christ with me,
Christ before me,
Christ behind me,
Christ in me,
Christ beneath me,
Christ above me,
Christ on my right,
Christ on my left,
Christ when I lie down,
Christ when I arise,



Christ when I arise, Christ in the heart of every man who thinks of me, Christ in the mouth of everyone who speaks of me, Christ in every eye that sees me,

Christ in every ear that hears me.

St. Patrick is one of the world's most popular saints. Born in Britian in 387, at the age of 14 he was captured by Irish pirates, and was held as a slave to heard and tend sheep. He escaped at age 20, was able to travel back home and reunite with his family. While living in Britian, he had a dream of returning to Ireland. The vision promoted him to study for the priesthood and was later ordained a bishop. In 433, he arrived back in Ireland where he began preaching and converting the pagan Irish and druid tribes. St. Patrick's method of sharing Christian belief in the Trinity, through the shamrock, is widely known. He worked many miracles and built churches throughout Irelan, wrote of his love for God in Confessions. After years of living in poverty, traveling and enduring much suffering he died March 17, 461.




