<u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>

Water Depth Adjustments

The IceQuacker® comes fully assembled and ready to use. Place the IceQuacker® in water, hook up the battery clamps to a fully charged 12V battery, and it's ready to go! The IceQuacker® can run in shallow water (as little as 12 inches) but it is loud since the blades are not fully submerged! For optimal use, we recommend a minimum water depth of 16 inches for the IceQuacker® as the blades are much quieter. The deep the water, the quieter it is! Placing the IceQuacker in water that is 4-6 feet deep, we recommend the motor be adjusted to the straight up position so that it "boils" the water and keeps the water from freezing in very cold temps.

General Usage

There is a spinning blade on this product. Keep your hands out of the blade when it is running! Duh!

Many times the stakes are not needed for the stand to stay in position. If you find the IceQuacker® moving while it is running, you probably need to stake it down! Don't pound them in with a sledgehammer as it's going to be hard to get them out!

We have found that the IceQuacker® will run for about 4-5 hours on a fully charged marine grade battery. Obviously different batteries have different capabilities and differing amounts of charge at any given time. Charge your battery when you see performance reduced.

If you would like to get more run time out of your IceQuacker®, Show Me Ducks has an optional 12V digital timer that can be used to cycle the IceQuacker® on and off. We have been able to keep ice open for 24-30 hours on one battery charge by setting the digital timer up correctly. We also carry an optional 100W solar panel to charge the battery during the day and keeping you from hauling batteries back and forth from your honey hole. The eye bolts on the sides of the frame is what tightens the motor and keeps it in position. You can lock the motor in position by loosening these eye bolts, fixing the motor in the correct position/orientation, and then tightening the eye bolts. You can use a stake to really tighten the eye bolts but be careful not to overtighten them. It's easy to over tighten!

Warning! The IceQuacker has a spinning plastic prop when it is running! If you put your hand in it when it is on, you can get hurt so don't do that! Disconnect the IceQuacker from the battery every time you are going to touch or go near it and don't run it when your prized hunting dog is standing beside it!



Warning! The battery you use for the IceQuacker can seriously hurt you. Please read and follow all the instructions and warnings that come with the battery. Don't allow any conductive material to come in contact with both terminals of the battery at the same time. Trust us.
