# STORY CONNECTION

We are meant to belong with friends who care about us and want to help us. Gertrude was that kind of friend to Horton.

Choose a reader for Gertrude and Horton's lines. (Script, p.55)

# **TRUTH & TREASURE**

**Scripture Decoding Race:** Split your small group into two groups. The following scriptures will be split and hidden around the room (slips of paper in different colours to easily identify which group they belong to), then once students have collected all strips, they will try to put their verses together. Verses are printed on a piece of paper as well so that students can use as reference to put the scriptures together correctly. First group to do both wins.

# **DISCOVERY TIME**

## **ACTIVITY**: SEPARATED WITHOUT GOD'S LOVE

Mark two lines on the floor with painter's tape about 4 feet in length. Lines are opposite each other with an open space in between. Choose two students to act out the prompt on each side of the line.

The prompt is first acted out in separation from each other. Then a student holding a sign that reads "God's Love" steps into the open space between the lines inviting the students to re-act the prompt, now belonging together.

Repeat with two new students and new prompt, each time demonstrating separation first (on each side of their line) and then belonging together with God's love (in the middle).

#### Prompts:

- First, walking through a dark, scary forest alone. Then, walking together feeling brave.
- First, riding a new rollercoaster, hands gripping the bars tightly. Then, riding together with arms raised and laughing.
- First, sitting all alone at lunch. Then, eating together as friends.
- First, receiving sad news on the phone. Then, comforting each other through the sadness.
- First, messing up a dance move and falling down. Then, messing up the dance move but helping each other get back up and continuing.

#### **PRAYER**

Dear God, thank you for loving us first. It's because of your love that we belong with you and with each other here in K2K.
