BOTTOM LINE

We can use our imagination to help us achieve our goals

STORY CONNECTION

The Spies Report – Numbers 13

There's a story from the Bible of men who used their imaginations, but in a way that kept them from God's dreams and plans.

Students act out story as Small Group Leader narrates.

Roles: Moses, Joshua, Caleb, Spies

Moses sent twelve men to spy out the land called Canaan. Moses told them, "See what the land is like and whether the people there are strong or weak, few or many. Is the land good or bad? What do they live in? Is their city protected by a wall around it?"

Joshua and Caleb took the spies and went up and explored the land of Canaan. They brought fruits like pomegranates and figs back with them. They brought a cluster of grapes so large, they carried it on a pole between two men. They told Moses the land flowed with milk and honey.

"Except!" they said, "We cannot go live there because the people are giants and will devour us. We seem like grasshoppers compared to their size."

Lovely work, everyone!

Can you imagine giants and tiny grasshoppers standing side by side? They could, and everyone believed them. They should have imagined themselves as strong and courageous to move into their promised land. Instead, they didn't go to the promised land of Canaan until forty years later!

DISCOVERY TIME

ACTIVITY: MISSION IMPOSSIBLE

Split students into two teams. They must work as a team to complete these "impossible" physical challenges using creativity, perseverance, and teamwork. Mark a starting and a finish line with Painter's tape. Team who finishes the most first, wins.



- Transport a pool noodle without using hands while hopping. If the noodle falls, start again.
- Move across the room standing on paper plates — feet must stay on plates the entire time.
- Transport a balloon from one end to the other without standing or walking. If the balloon falls, start again.
- Using only one finger each, move a stack of four cups from one side of the room to the other without dropping them. If they fall, start again.
- Students are given a stack of paper and lay out a path across the floor and must work as a team to get across the papers. If any member steps off a paper, the whole team must restart.
- Each team must hop on one foot from point A to B — but they can “link up” with others for balance. If anyone falls over, start again.
- Teams must crawl or army-crawl across the space — but every 10 seconds, the leader shouts “freeze!” and they must hold position.
