SUPPLIES

- Craft supplies done as large group (pipe cleaners, tissue paper, paint, forks, yarn, hot glue, pipe cleaners)
- Colouring Page with Psalm 139:13-14, I John 3:1, Jeremiah 31:3, Jeremiah 29:11-14 to put in student's script binder
- Markers, pens
- Bible marked and open to Psalm 139:13-14, I John 3:1, Jeremiah 31:3, Jeremiah 29:11-14
- Chairs arranged in a circle

AS STUDENTS ARRIVE

Congratulations on Auditions

- What was it like to audition in front of people?

STORY CONNECTION

Choose reader for Simba, Rafiki, and Mufasa.

Rafiki asks Simba, "Who are you?" (Script, p104)

Simba says, "I thought I knew. Now I'm not so sure."

Rafiki knows. "You're Mufasa's boy."

In the pool of water, Simba catches Mufasa's reflection and hears him say, "You have forgotten who you are. Look inside you, Simba. You must take your place in the circle of life." (Script, p110)

What happened that led Simba to forget who he was and his royal lineage?

DISCOVERY TIME

CRAFT | Lion Keepsake

Students will each get a canvas and use the provided supplies to create a Lion face. Written on each Canvas will be Lion King Jr and K2K 2025 so that students will have something at home that reminds them that they are part of the K2K Community- that they belong. This activity will be done as a large group.

TRUTH & TREASURE

Supplies: Scriptures are written out on a journal page for students to put in script binders.

Remind students that you are not who your past mistakes say you are. You are not who other people say you are. You are not what your feelings say you are. You are who God says you are. God wants you to know that you are amazing and wonderful, just as you are.

**As students colour in pages, read these verses and their titles out loud*

You are amazing and wonderful.

"You created my inmost being. You knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made, I know that full well." Psalm 139:13-14 NIV

You are greatly loved.

"See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" 1 John 3:1 NIV

You are worthy to be loved.

"I have loved you with an everlasting love. I have drawn you with unfailing kindness." Jeremiah 31:3 NIV

You have purpose.

"I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you." Jeremiah 29:11-14 NIV
