# **GAME | Make a Who Clover**

Create the stem: Twist two different coloured pipe cleaners together for a spiraled stem.

Create the Pom Pom top

\*Make sure students don't hold their fingers too close together when wrapping

Twist the pipe cleaners around the middle of the pom pom to attach the stem before cutting the pom pom open



# **TRUTH & TREASURE**

Supplies: Scriptures are written out on a journal page for students to put in script binders.

Remind students that you are not who your past mistakes say you are. You are not who other people say you are. You are not what your feelings say you are. You are who God says you are.God wants you to know that you are amazing and wonderful, just as you are.

"I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you." Jeremiah 29:11-14 NIV
