Our School:

What is your school's mission or educational philosophy?

Our Soccer Program:

What is your coaching philosophy?

Our coaching philosophy is centered around the <u>key qualities of a player</u>. We aim to create a challenging yet supportive environment where players are pushed to reach their full potential.

What is the level of the training?

Our soccer training is designed for committed and ambitious players who aspire to compete at a high level. At Evolution MN, student-athletes will take part in on-field technical training sessions three days a week, and tactical training sessions where they will watch films and analyze the various aspects of each game two days a week.

How many hours of soccer training will students receive per week?

At Evolution MN, our daily academic to extracurricular (sports, physical education, etc.) ratio is 70:30. This adds up to approximately one hour per day of combined on-field and off-field training athletic training.

What is your student-teacher ratio?

At Evolution MN, we are committed to having classroom sizes that are no larger than 15 students per teacher.



Is the atmosphere of your school competitive or more nurturing?

Evolution MN seeks to create an atmosphere that offers a blend of both. Being a school that also focuses on sports, there will always be a certain level of competitiveness to be expected. What is your academic focus?

What curriculum do you use?

How much independent and collaborative learning do you offer?
