#### Christmas Card treasures


Turn old Christmas cards into beautiful keepsake ornaments! It's a fun, simple way to give new life to cards you've received and add a handmade touch to your tree.

- 2. Cut out the circles and glue the backs together.
- 3. Decorate the edges with glitter or ribbon for extra sparkle.
- 4. Punch a hole at the top and thread yarn or ribbon through to hang.
