Seussical Jr. Character Breakdown

Remember that every role is important. Together, these characters bring the show to life!

JoJo/Boy: JoJo is a "Thinker". He/she is a smart child with a wild imagination. JoJo can be played as being a little bit awkward, a little bit of a loner, or simply a rambunctious kid whose "Thinks" get him into constant trouble. By the end of the show, he/she learns what it means to be a responsible member of his/her community, using the power and possibilities of his own "Thinks".

The Cat in the Hat: is the essence of mischief, fun, and imagination. The Cat stirs things up and causes trouble but always sets things right again.

Horton the Elephant: is a gentle giant. Think of Horton as a big-hearted, blue-collar guy who is steadfast, responsible, and always tries to do the right thing. He is sympathetic and receptive to the world around him. He belies in the inherent goodness of the world, so it's no surprise that he always looks for the good in others. Horton goes on quiet a journey throughout the show but stays true to himself, even when the going gets tough.

Mr. Mayor: A parent trying hard to raise a child with a big imagination. Him and Mrs. Mayor love JoJo dearly and try their best to make the right choices as parents, even if JoJo doesn't always understand them. He is an upstanding member of his community.

Mrs. Mayor: Husband to Mr. Mayor and mother of JoJo. She is an upstanding member of her community and loves JoJo dearly.

Gertrude McFuzz: is very self-conscious about her one-feather tail. Gertrude gains confidence throughout the show, changing from an anxious, nervous, shy bird into someone whose self-worth doesn't rest on her appearance. In other words, Gertrude realizes what's truly important in her life. **Mayzie La Bird:** is self-centered, vain, and manipulative. She ultimately means no harm, but she's immature and makes selfish decisions. In giving up her egg to Horton once and for all, she has a moment of self-awareness – she realizes she isn't the kind of bird who would be a good parent, and she does the best thing she can for the egg.

Wickersham Brothers: They are not bad guys! They tease, play pranks, and get a kick out of making mischief, although often at another's expense.

Bird Girls: They are a fabulous group of birds who know everything there is to know about the goings on in the jungle and support Mayzie throughout the show.

Sour Kangaroo: is loud, brassy, and a lot of fun. She's got a lot of attitude but isn't mean – she's just very confident and unafraid to tell it like it is.

Young Kangaroo: is the Sour Kangaroos feisty child. She/he may be pint sized, but she/he has a big personality and is following in their mother's footsteps.


Judge Yertle the Turtle: is the authoritative judge who presides over Horton's trial at the end of the show.

Vlad Vladikoff: is the black-bottomed eagle who floes off with the Whos.


The Grinch: is arguably the most famous Seuss character of all! He has a brief, fun cameo in Seussical Jr.


The Whos: are the citizens of Whoville and they look a lot like you and me, only so small they are invisible to the naked eye. They are a tight-knit, supportive community.


(The CAT begins to "create" the Seussian world of imagination for the BOY, who will enter this world and become JOJO.)

(Throughout this litany of JoJo's behavior, we need to know that the CAT was responsible. The CAT may be guilt ridden or highly amused. JOJO, of course, sees the CAT reacting, but MR. MAYOR and MRS. MAYOR don't.)

MRS. MAYOR

You gave Miss O'Dooley a nervous conniption!

MR. MAYOR

Your Thinks were so wild they disrupted your classes And made Mrs. Mackel-Who drop her new glasses. Which is why you're suspended!

MRS. MAYOR

Yes, that's what they said!

MR. MAYOR

Young man, what in Who has got into your head?!

JOJO

I... um...

(JOJO looks to the CAT for help, but the CAT makes it clear JOJO's on his own.)

MR. MAYOR

Now Horton has found us. We're safe on a clover. But clearly our troubles are far, far from over.

MRS. MAYOR

We don't mean to scold you. We love you, oh, yes, dear. But couldn't you try thinking just a bit less, dear?

MR. MAYOR

Stop telling such outlandish tales.

MRS. MAYOR

Stop turning minnows into whales.

MR. MAYOR

Now take your bath and go to bed.

MRS. MAYOR

And think some Normal Thinks instead.

(MR. MAYOR and MRS. MAYOR exit, leaving JOJO alone to take his bath. <u>#9 – OH, THE THINKS YOU CAN</u> <u>THINK! (REPRISE)</u> begins.)
