

MINUTES OF THE JUNE 12, 2025, COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT MEETING

Moving the meeting on to agenda item 4 to update the committee on the District's fire services. Previous and upcoming apparatus purchases were a topic of discussion along with call statistics covering the District's providers.

Agenda item 6 was next on the agenda to receive an update on the District's EMS. Topics covered included the call statistics of the District along with mutual aid calls that were covered for outside agencies. The committee received information regarding upcoming purchases of ambulances to sustain the growing needs of the District.
