MINIMUM SERVICES

Our minimum services charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person, whether by cremation or burial.

Our minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve, and includes transferring the deceased from the place of death (residence, hospital, airport, Coroner's office etc.) to our holding room. The deceased will be placed in a casket/cremation unit of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for burial or cremation.

Once the required documentation is ready, (death has been registered, and if applicable, coroner's certificate for cremation has been obtained) the deceased will be transported in a service van/SUV to the cemetery or crematorium at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as arranged.

What is NOT included in the minimum service charge

- mileage beyond 25 km
- pacemaker/radioactive implant removal (for cremation)
- pallbearers (for burial service)
- merchandise such as - urn, outer burial unit
- applicable taxes (HST)
- ***Disbursements** - paid to third parties on your behalf, such as cremation fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, interment fee (as described on page 4).

While identification of the deceased may be made with minimum required preparation, you may wish to consider "basic preparation of remains" as it might afford a more peaceful final viewing experience.

*NOTES

- Although we are a Transfer Service Operator - Class 1, and prohibited by law from arranging, conducting or participating in a visitation, or funeral service, at which human remains are present, we may offer transportation services to and from a location of a visitation or service that is led by a family. Speak to your funeral director for details
- Grave dressing and lowering device (artificial grass and mechanical device used to lower casket) may be required for some cemeteries. Your funeral director will advise cost and if it is necessary.

Disbursements

as applicable

*Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the transfer service to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice and are out of our control. Such items include but are not limited to:

Municipal Death Registration Fee \$30

This is a fee charged by the local municipality (City of Waterloo) to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality will issue a burial permit, then forward the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay, Ontario.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) Consumer Protection Fee \$30

The BAO is responsible for protection of the public interest. It regulates and ensures compliance with the laws, conducts inspections and supports licensed professionals in the funeral industry across the province of Ontario. The BAO is wholly funded by licensee fees not tax dollars,

Coroner's Fee \$75

This is a provincially set fee, charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation, alternative disposition or "Out of Province" shipping to take place.

Cremation Fee \$678.00 HST Incl.

This is the fee charged by the crematorium. Fees vary by crematoriums. The transfer service uses Southwest Crematorium, located in Parkview Cemetery (335 University Ave. E., Waterloo)

Interment Fee \$Varies

This is the fee charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave/niche. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave/niche.

Media Notices \$Varies

This is the fee charged by newspapers, radio stations or other media outlets for publishing death notices on their platforms.

Discription of Services & Fees

Any services makred with an asterisk (*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct burial or cremation and may not be deducted.

***Professional & staff services**

- Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs and drafting death notices. Co-ordination of all activities before, during and after services that have been provided by us, and those provided by third party suppliers (ie-cemetery, crematorium and/or media outlets). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance, utilities, accounting/office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance. **\$295**

***Documentation**

- Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested including but not limited to: death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, cremation application, interment permission form. Third party fees for these documents are not included and are itemized on page 4. Ten (10) Funeral Director Statement of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document, however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Talk to your funeral director if a government "Certified Death Certificate" is necessary. **\$230**

***Minimum preparation of remains**

- This service is a minimum requirement. The deceased is checked for personal effects (ie-jewelry) which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed, or for cremation purposes, a pacemaker (which will be removed), and placed into the selected casket/cremation unit. **\$100**

***Basic preparation of remains**

- This service includes those described in "minimum preparation of remains" above, plus bathing, dressing, setting of features for identification or viewing without embalming, basic hairstyling and cosmetics if desired. **\$250**

Facilities

***Facilities for preparation/sheltering**

- A secure and private room used to prepare and/or shelter the deceased until time of burial, cremation or alternative disposition. This charge applies whenever the deceased's body is in our facility. The body can **ONLY** be held in our facility for a period of up to **3 days**.

Transportation

*Initial transfer of remains

- Vehicle, trained transfer service staff and specialized equipment used to transfer the deceased into our care from the place of death (ie-residence, hospital, airport, Coroner's office, etc.). Additional mileage fees apply beyond 25 km. **\$260**
- **If additional staff are required to assist due to difficult circumstances - \$150**

*Final transfer of remains

- Vehicle (service van or SUV), trained transfer service staff to transfer deceased to final place of disposition (crematorium or cemetery) **\$216 - \$300**

Additional mileage

- Charge per kilometer (both ways) for use of any vehicle over the initial 25 km radius from the location of the transfer service **\$1.90 per km**

Other Services

Aftercare Package

- Assistance with government notifications (CPP/OAS & CRA), government applications (CPP Death Benefit, CPP Survivor Benefit), government cancellations (SIN, HST/GST, OTB, Driver's Licence, Health Card, Photo Card, Passport, Firearm Licence), Estate Fraud Protection from identity theft/fraud. Extensive estate guidance checklist. **\$425**

*Removal of pacemaker or other implants

- This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body. The removal of a pacemaker or other implant **must** be carried out by a licensed funeral director and the device disposed of following government guidelines. Please speak to your funeral director if the deceased was receiving Brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or Radioisotope treatments prior to death as they may not be able to be cremated. **\$75**

Refundable deposit for holding cremated remains

- If the deceased's authorized representative would like the cremated remains held at the transfer service for an extended period of time (longer than 3 months), a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed after one year of the cremation, the transfer service may use the deposit to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of their choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded to the authorized representative. **\$350**

Cremation Container and Caskets

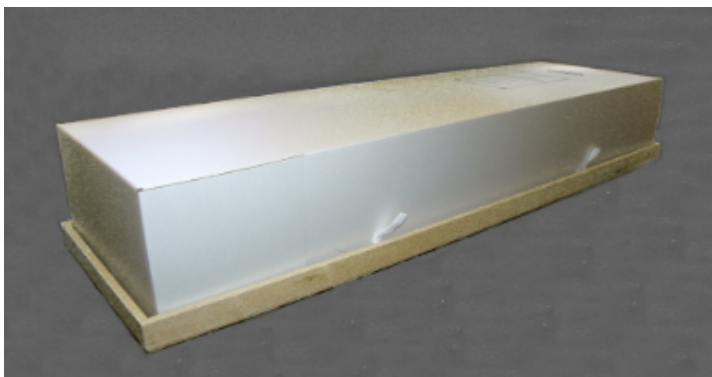
The following cremation units/caskets are those generally available. Additional options are available upon request. **Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.** *Oversized caskets are available for additional cost. Speak to your funeral director about your specific needs.*

Minimum requirement for burial

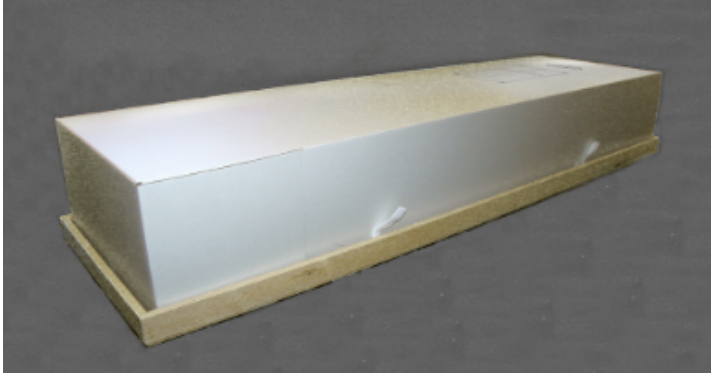
- The least expensive wood casket is suitable, and is required by most cemeteries' by-laws for interment, in the interest of health and safety of the workers involved in the interment process. A metal casket may also be used for burial. A growing number of cemeteries in Ontario offer "green" burials, which may consist of interment of a body without a casket. Since there is no legal definition for a "green" burial, it varies from one cemetery to another. For more information, please speak to one of our licensees or visit www.greenburialcanada.ca

Minimum requirement for cremation

- A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation.
- **METAL or STEEL CASKETS ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR CREMATION, but may be requested for traditional burial.**
- *Other caskets constructed of wood and/or similar may be requested for cremation*

Vaults & Grave Liners

Outer burial containers listed below are for standard adult size caskets. Oversize vaults are available to accommodate plus-size caskets. *Price may or may not include grave set up and lowering device fees.*

You do not have to purchase a vault, unless the Medical Officer of Health has made the use of vaults and grave liners mandatory in the entire cemetery. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults or grave liners are required, however, the operator must have another area where vaults or grave liners are not required, so that consumers have a choice. A vault or grave liner may be recommended when there are environmental conditions such as poor drainage, or for practical or aesthetic reasons.

Payment, Financing & Funding

For services at time of death:

- ***Payment is due at the time of signing the contract.***
- Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit or most major credit cards
- Credit card payments are subject to a surcharge of 2.4% on the amount paid
- Payment plans are discretionary, and financing charges will apply to payment plans, if allowed & approved.

Financial assistance for burial or cremation services are available through various governmenta agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies.

TRUST - You pay in full for the services and supplies selected at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment by pre-authorized debit (void cheque/PAD) or credit card (*credit card payments are subject to a surcharge fee of 2.4% on the amount paid*). Funds are held in the purchaser's name and assigned to the transfer service.

INSURANCE - You may purchase an insurance/group annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the insurance/group annuity policy will be used to pay for your selected services or supplies at the time they are delivered. Payment is preferred by pre-authorized debit (void cheque/PAD) for single payments (*credit card payments are subject to a surcharge fee of 2.4% on the amount paid*). **Time payment plans may be made by pre-authorized debit/chequing or credit card, but limitations and/or restrictions may apply.** The policy is held in your name and assigned to the transfer service. Terms and conditions and cancellation policies are set by the insurance company.

Guarantee - When paid in full, in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest/growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest/growth are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, the transfer service will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
