This unforgettable journey blends devotion, culture, and community as we gather for prayer, reflection, and awe-inspiring encounters with the sacred. Come ready to be moved—body, soul, and spirit.

### Day by Day Itinerary January 30: USA\*Mexico City\*Puebla

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart the U.S. on our international flight to Mexico City. Upon arrival, we'll be warmly welcomed by our professional tour escort and board our deluxe motorcoach for a scenic drive to Puebla—a charming city steeped in colonial history and culture. Upon arrival, we'll gather for a private Mass at the hotel (pending confirmation), followed by dinner and overnight accommodations in Puebla. (D)

#### January 31: Puebla

We begin our day with Mass at the breathtaking **Rosary Chapel**, a true jewel of baroque artistry (subject to confirmation). Our journey through Puebla continues with visits to the city's magnificent **Cathedral** and the **Church of San Francisco**, where we'll have the opportunity to view the incorrupt body of **St. Sebastian**. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure—wander the colorful streets, savor local cuisine, or shop for the region's famous Talavera pottery. Dinner and overnight in Puebla. (B/D)

#### February 1 : Puebla • Ocotlan • San Miguel del Milagro • Mexico City



After breakfast, we depart for Mexico City, pausing at two cherished pilgrimage sites along the way. Our first stop is **Ocotlan**, where **Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego**, imprinting her image on an oak tree—now enshrined in the stunning **Sanctuary of the Virgin of Ocotlan**. We then continue to the **Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro**, home to a miraculous spring of healing waters, where pilgrims may collect holy water. In the afternoon, we arrive in Mexico City and enjoy a panoramic tour of the historic **Zócalo**, the vibrant heart of the city. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

#### February 2 : Mexico City – Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe

This morning, we journey to the **Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, the most visited Catholic shrine in the world and the sacred site of Our Lady's miraculous apparitions to **Saint Juan Diego**. We will join pilgrims from around the globe in **celebrating public Mass**, followed by a guided tour of the Basilica grounds, including the **original tilma**, chapels, and surrounding sacred spaces. The rest of the day allows time for personal prayer and reflection. Dinner and over night in Mexico City. (B/D)

#### February 3: MEXICO CITY

Today, we explore the colorful and historic neighborhood of **Coyoacán**, known for its rich artistic heritage and colonial charm. Our morning begins with a visit to the **Church of St. John the Baptist**, followed by a journey to **Xochimilco**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its scenic canals and floating gardens. Here, we will celebrate **Mass at the Church of San Bernardino** (subject to availability), then enjoy a **traditional** 



**trajinera (gondola) ride** through the canals with lunch served onboard. The afternoon is yours to relax, reflect, or explore at your leisure. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. (B/L/D)

#### February 4: MEXICO CITY / USA

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our flight back to the USA, arriving the same day. Reflect on the profound spiritual experiences of this pilgrimage as you return home with memories that will last a lifetime. (B)

**Tour Prices:** All prices in this brochure are based on land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 25 passengers. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Sue Smith Vacations an additional charge will apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Physical Disclaimer for pilgrimage - Pilgrimages, by their nature, are about a journey. You can expect to walk 3-7 miles daily to participate in all Masses and sightseeing. Some days could be fewer than 5 miles if it involves mostly traveling by bus to the next city. In historic towns, many streets are uneven, made of cobblestone or not paved. You can also expect that you will have to go up and down stairs to get on and off the bus and ascend and descend hills to get into churches, hotels and religious sites.

In addition, it is very unlikely we will be at hotels with porters who can help you with your suitcases. You will be responsible for taking them from the bus to your hotel room and back down. While we want everyone interested to join us, we want to be clear about what you could expect. If you have physical limitations, please prayerfully consider if joining us would be the best pilgrimage experience for you or your family member.

**Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments:** Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per-person deposit. Deposit of \$500 plus the cost of travel insurance is required to hold your spot on the tour. Deposits and tour costs are *non-refundable*. Final Payment is due by November 30, 2025. **Late Reservations:** If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services.

**Travel Documents:** A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for U.S. passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-U.S. citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip.

In addition non-U.S. citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the U.S. SSV and its partner vendors assume no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. SSV and its partner vendors will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation. Final Documents: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within three weeks of departure. Documents are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: Air from JFK in Main Cabin Economy (Coach) is included.

**Rooms:** Prices are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room. Single rooms are available at an additional cost of \$480.00, in some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers.

**Medical Conditions:** While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance. SSV and its partner vendors are not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

Once the tours commence, there will be no refunds on missed or unused portions of the tour programs. Purchase of Travel Insurance, at the time of deposit, is strongly recommended.


