FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Who holds you together when illness calls?

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks a question that cuts straight to the heart of our lives: "But who do you say that I am?"

When life is comfortable, answering with St. Peter that Jesus is "the Christ, the Son of the living God" comes easily. But when serious illness, chronic pain, or the challenges of old age strips away our independence, that question demands a deeper response. Who is Jesus to us when we are suffering?

Today, our parish celebrates the **Anointing of the Sick**. This sacrament is a direct exercise of the authority Jesus gave to the Church to "bind and loose." Through the holy oil and the prayers of the priest, Christ meets you exactly where it hurts.

Remember, Our Lord Jesus Christ holds us steady when our health wavers. Whether you are stepping forward to receive the sacrament today or praying from the pews, let this Mass remind you that the "gates of the netherworld"—including despair, illness, and death—will never have the final word.
