GUIDELINES FOR LENT	
◆ FASTING means eating only one normal-sized meal & two small meals, with no snacks.	
◆ ABSTINENCE means eating no meat. Milk, eggs, and fish are fine. Abstinence binds all Catholics over age 14.	
◆ FRIDAYS of LENT are days of abstinence.	
◆ FASTING binds all Catholics 18-59 years of age.
