Scriptural Readings Acts 2: 1-11 They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak. All who heard them heard in their native language. **Psalm 104** Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.
1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13 Different gifts, but the same Spirit. In one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, able to say "Jesus is Lord." **John 20: 19-23** The risen Jesus meets his disciples: "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them."
Catechism References 152, 683-686 Who is the Holy Spirit? **731-732** The Pentecost: Christ's Passover fulfilled and the Holy Trinity fully revealed. **1087, 1120** "Apostolic succession" as entrusting the Holy Spirit by Christ to the apostles and successors. **1287-1288** All the baptized share the messianic character of Christ.
781-786 The Church in the Spirit: priestly, prophetic, royal People of God. **976** Christ gives the Spirit for forgiveness of sin.

Lifeline to Sanctity and Sanity

Greetings everyone:

After being challenged by how our smartphones can become a near occasion of sin, I just want you to know my cure-all, especially after having four hectic weeks of welcoming Bishop Mario for Confirmations, First Communion, Mother's Day, and congratulating our graduates and offering our blessings and gratitude for their accomplishments, then the engine light to Buick which the Oblates got me to use for the ministry here started to glow and the question may arise in one's mind and heart; "What's next Lord?"

My cure-all can handle it with grace and even humor, I may dare say. It's the rosary. I have earnestly tried to figure out how Saint Padre Pio prayed all those rosaries during his day-to-day life, especially after an early morning Mass and at times 16 hours in the Confessional. Where did he have the time? Well, one thing for sure, Padre Pio was not distracted by smartphones or television sets and yet praying about 35 (Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries (15 Decades)) Rosaries is a task and a half, but one thing has become clear: don't leave home without it. Always have one on hand in your pocket, backpack, or purse, and when you've got a moment, pull it out and pray, even if it's one decade (an Our Father, 10 Hail Marys and a Glory Be). Even take it to your bed and put it on your nightstand, it amazing how much good prayer time, you can cultivate after waking up at an odd hour like 2 AM and how wonderful your sleep is as your drift off praying the rosary. Remember if that happens to you, your guardian angel will finish the rosary for you. I learned that from a holy priest from Alaska during my ministry there.

Keeping the rosary at hand and praying it when the opportunity, even in hectic moments, has offered peace and hopefulness to me. So why not give it a try?

It will truly add sanity and sanctity to your life!
