FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

How To Pray the Rosary for Reparation

Greetings everyone:

I would like to offer a few suggestions for praying for the sins of others and atoning for them (known as Reparation) with the Rosary (this October's Devotion). It is a powerful way for Catholics to express sorrow for sin and cooperate with Christ's work of salvation.

- 1. Start with an intention.** Clearly state your intention to offer the rosary in reparation for sins, either your own, those of the world, or specifically against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- 2. Follow the traditional rosary structure.** Pray the rosary as usual, including all standard prayers.
- 3. Reflect on the mysteries with an intention of atonement.** Meditate on the mysteries, uniting your prayers with Christ's redemptive acts.
- 4. Recite the Fatima Prayer after each decade.** Include the "O my Jesus" prayer after the Glory Be in each decade.

May these suggestions be a help.
