# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

What is a "Living Rosary?"

## Greetings everyone:

As I mentioned last week, people are often mentioning to me that they don't have time to pray a regular rosary of five decades (a decade is 1 Our Father, 10 Hail Marys and 1 Glory Be).

Here is an easy method in which you and four of your family or friends can pray the rosary each day. It's called the "Living Rosary" and I learned this from an Oblate priest at the Oblate Shrine in Colebrook NH, whose name was

Fr. Roland Lavallee OMI. The kicker is that all you do is pray one decade, not five.

Interested? Well, here's the information.

## **The Living Rosary Association**

This version is a commitment-based devotion, organized as a prayer association. It allows people to participate together in prayer even when they are in different locations. The Universal Living Rosary Association was revived in 1986 based on the original 1826 model created by Venerable Pauline Jaricot.

### How it works

- **--Assigned decades.** A group is formed, and each member is assigned to pray a specific decade (one Our Father and ten Hail Marys) and meditate on its corresponding mystery.
- --Individual daily prayer. Each person prays their assigned decade daily at a time and place of their own convenience.
- --The group completes a full rosary. By each person fulfilling their part, the group's collective prayers create a complete rosary every day.
- **--Shared intentions.** The group can pray for a specific intention, such as for the missions, the church, or a personal cause, unifying their daily prayers.

### Purpose and benefits

- **--Strengthens community**. Both versions build a sense of unity and shared purpose through prayer, connecting people physically or spiritually.
- --Makes prayer more interactive. The physical living rosary can be a powerful and memorable way to teach and engage children and adults alike.
- **--Encourages daily prayer.** The ongoing association helps members stay committed to a consistent daily prayer habit by knowing others depend on them.
- **--Multiplies graces.** Participants can receive the spiritual graces of praying a full rosary, with each member also praying for the intentions of the others.

So, all you need to do is have 4 other people join in and inform me so I can recognize and record that your group exists. I have some other instructions and pamphlets to help.
