# Jesus is risen: Now what?

If doctors make the worst patients, then surely public speakers are the toughest audience in the pews.

When I'm benched on the average Sunday, attending to the homilist, my bottom line invariably remains: "So what?" We've all heard the readings, listened to the preacher "open them up," but where are we now? Any better off from where we were at the start of the hour? Do we know what to do next as a result of our time invested here?

So when I join the assembly at the Easter Vigil or on this happy morning, the question on my mind is: Jesus is risen—now what? Purists and mystics will argue that it's enough to "be here now" and delight in the theological excitement. The crucified Son of God has broken the vice-grip of original sin, death is no longer the end of the road, the gates of heaven

are swung wide, and salvation of the human race is achieved! If that isn't enough for you, maybe you need a vacation.

The problem is, most folks in the pews have heard all this before. They've—I should say, we've—survived many an Easter no worse for wear, but honestly, no better. We're happy things turned out so well for Jesus, and we hope he'll keep his promises to our dearly departed grandma, too. Because a lot of us have stood at the mouth of the tomb and found it sealed shut, quite frankly. Grandma's gone; so are others marked with the sign of faith like her—and a few others marked by their refusal to gamble on religion. We worry vaguely about friends and relatives who put their chips in a different dealer's hands. But that's as close as we come to genuine faith in the message. We who have never stood at the entrance to an empty tomb and seen the loosened cloths find it hard to imagine

what that's like.

Here is where the presider must truly be the celebrant and the medium match the message, embodying the Good News and demonstrating the joy his own faith provides for him. It's almost indescribable how much damage a gloomy Easter preacher can wreak. It's likewise astonishing how much faith is enkindled by an authentic Easter testimony: He is risen! I have seen the Lord! The preacher who has seen the Lord can witness to that experience with enthusiasm and conviction. The one who hasn't can't offer the Easter proclamation.

That's not meant as a test of your vocation; it's a call to reflect deeply on what you truly believe and are willing to declare out loud. Tell the truth. Pray for the Spirit's guidance.

## CATHOLIC Q&A

### QUESTION

Why is the Easter season so long? And should we be doing something special for it?

### ANSWER

You will probably noticed the priest continuing to wear white vestments at the Sunday liturgy. While we celebrate Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday, the Easter season extends fifty days — just over seven weeks — from Easter Sunday to Pentecost. For most of that time — about six weeks — Jesus is still with the disciples, teaching and encouraging them. The Easter season isn't just a celebration of when Jesus is with us. At the Last Supper, Jesus promised to send an "advocate" or "counselor" when he left. At the Ascension, he directs the disciples to await "power from on high" — the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Ascension completes the Paschal Mystery, beginning with Jesus' suffering and death and continuing in the resurrection. But the Holy Spirit ushers in a new era for the Church.

After spending weeks in prayer, fasting, and service during Lent, it may seem odd that we don't widely have similar practices for Easter. That doesn't mean you can't embrace the season! Commit to taking moments of little joy throughout the weeks, like random acts of kindness towards others. Consider reading the Acts of the Apostles to learn more about the early Church or picking up an Easter devotional to pray with. He is still risen indeed!

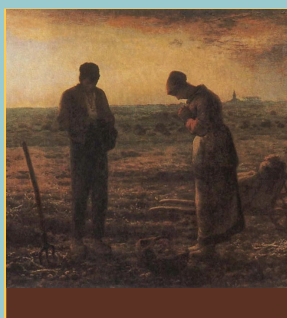
