# Dou You Really Want Mercy?

Nothing makes nice Catholic Bible study groups more disgruntled than the parable of the landowner who pays everyone alike, no matter how much they worked. It's not fair, they argue. What's the point of being good all your life when a deathbed conversion is enough to gain you the whole enchilada of salvation?

They don't seem to notice that the person they're arguing with is Jesus, and the cause they're arguing for is less mercy. (What would they prefer: more wrath? The surprising answer is yes—so long as it's aimed at someone else!) What's really illuminating is that many are apparently convinced that being good is undesirable. When we protest this parable, we're saying that if it were up to us, we'd be bad as long as possible.

Is a good life not a benefit in itself? The philosopher Blaise Pascal thought

so. In his famous defense of faith known as Pascal's Wager, he said believing in God is a win-win situation, whether or not there is a God. If it turns out there is, and you've been virtuous, you win the prize of everlasting life. If there is no God and you lived virtuously, you've lost nothing and in fact come out ahead. The virtuous person has the best possible life, the love and esteem of others, and the satisfaction of great moral purpose.

What worked for Pascal, however, obviously doesn't for the average modern believer. A lot of us are not convinced, frankly, that laboring in the vineyard is the best possible use of our time. The prophet Isaiah seems to confirm the disconnect between God's ways and ours. God's thoughts are so much higher, better, truer than ours that whatever we have in mind it simply doesn't compare. If we are to "put on the mind of Christ," in Saint Paul's words, to reach for those higher

thoughts, this decision will inevitably displace our own baser ideas. So right now I'm thinking a pizza would be nice and so would skipping the rest of the work day in favor of lolling in front of a matinee. Putting on the mind of Christ keeps me at my desk and fat-free, but is that a personal misery? If it made no difference to God which choice I make so long as I get viaticum at the end, would I be on the phone to Pizza Hut right now?

The truth is, those who worked in the vineyard since morning have already been paid with the satisfaction of a life of integrity. Those who wasted their lives have to live—and die—with that reality, which is not a pleasant prospect. That God's mercy encompasses both parties is a pretty wonderful thing.

## MEET SEMINARIAN NICHOLAS DUNN

Nicholas Dunn is in his sixth and final year of priestly formation for the Diocese of San Diego, pursuing a Master's in Divinity and a Master's in Theological Studies at the Franciscan School of Theology. He serves at Mission Basilica San Diego de Alcalá Parish.



The oldest of six children, Nicholas was born April 26, 2002, in Orange County, Calif. After moving to Oceanside with his family, he attended St. Margaret Parish in Oceanside, where he served as an altar server until he entered the seminary. He was homeschooled through high school and attended Palomar Community College.

In 2021, Nicholas was accepted into the Program of Priestly Formation in the Diocese of San Diego. From 2021 to 2023, he studied at the University of San Diego, where he earned his Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy and served at the Immaculata Parish, teaching Confirmation and OCIA and coordinating altar server training.

In 2023, he was admitted as a Candidate for Holy Orders and began his graduate studies at the Franciscan School of Theology. Nicholas' pastoral assignments include Holy Spirit Parish, San Diego (2023); Corpus Christi Parish, Bonita (2024); Sacred Heart and St. Margaret Mary Parish, Brawley (2024); Ascension Parish, Tierrasanta (2024-2025); Clinical Pastoral Education at UCSD Jacobs (Summer 2025); and Sacred Heart Parish, Coronado (2025-2026). Nicholas will be ordained a Deacon in December.
