A group of Zion folks are planning a garage sale to support the camp.



Good Friday service was held at 6 p.m. with Rev Wendy Wood leading a very thoughtful service with a good attendance.


Sunday Morning we met at John and Susan Koersen's farm under a cloudy sky for our Easter sunrise service led by Rev Heather Burton.
