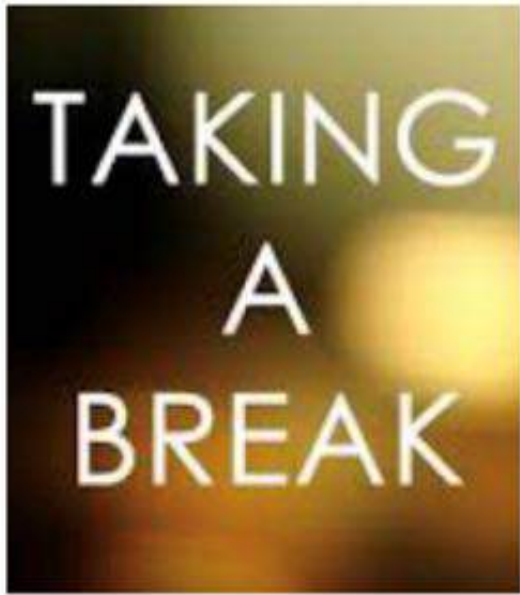

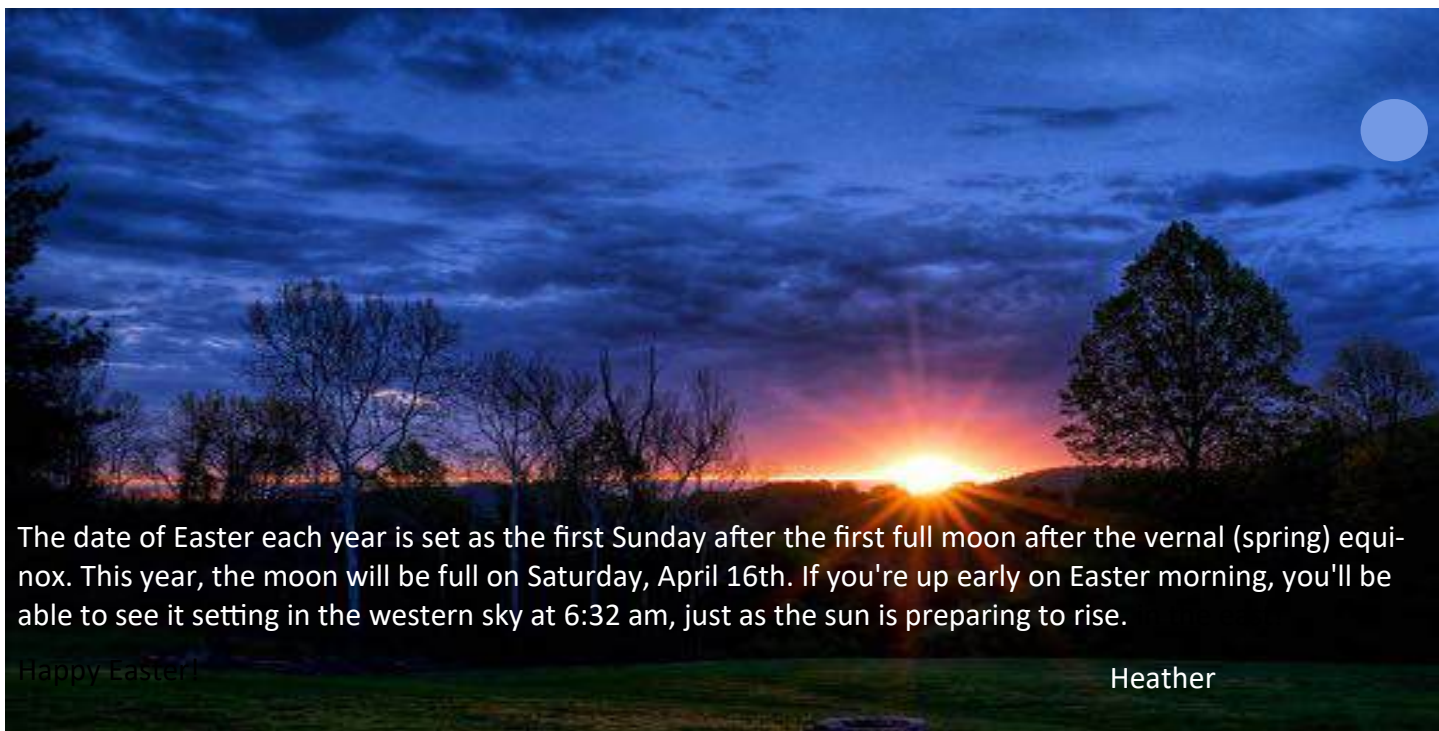
St. Andrew's United Church will be holding their AGM on **April 24th** following the church service.

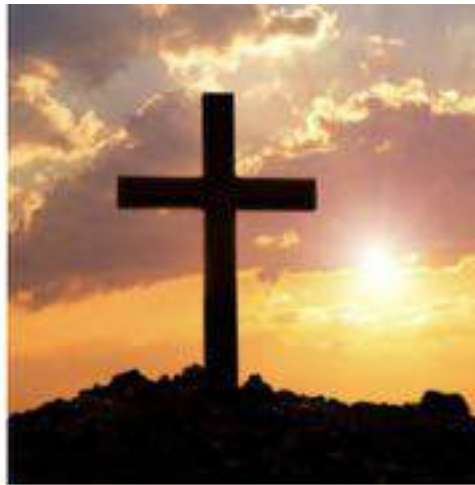
