

Grow a Row

Although the Spallumcheen Armstrong Food Initiative Society (SAFIS) won't be starting the Produce Sharing Program at the Community Garden behind the red caboose until July 8th, we are encouraging anyone who has room in their garden to plant an extra row or two.

Any excess produce can be brought to the volunteers at the Community Garden between 9 and 10 on Monday.

From 10 to 12 o'clock this will be passed on to people who do not have access to fresh fruits and vegetables. To accommodate people who are working or who cannot drop off or pick up in the morning, we will also be open from 5:00 to 6:30 for drop off and pick up.

The program will run every Monday from July 8th to October 7th. This is the 16th year SAFIS has run the program. With the increase in food prices and other commodities, the free fresh produce will benefit people more than ever. Sharing produce not only provides people with fresh locally grown food but generates a conversation about growing food, preparing food and storing food.
