

The Church Hall Roof

and Church Finances.....

*Let the rains come!
No more leaky 70 year old church hall
roof!
No more drip pans inside the hall!
Yeah!*

As promised, Quality Roofing finished installing the new hall roof by the end of July, and on August 15 Zion's cheque for payment in full was cashed.

In the past week several members have inquired about the effect of the new roof on Zion's finances. The total cost of the roof was \$19,263.30 with GST included. We will recover GST of \$458.65 leaving \$18,804.65 to come out of the Building Fund.

As you can see in the statement below, payment for the roof left the Building Fund \$8,222.30 in the hole. The \$8,222.30 has been temporarily borrowed from operating reserves.

Our total operating revenue to the end of July is \$12,500 more than last year, and that is over and above the \$7,048.93 donated to the Building Fund. We are very grateful and encouraged by the additional offerings made, and the energy put into fundraising, catering, and rentals. But we still have a YTD operating deficit of (\$7,144.56).

Donations to replenish the funds used for the hall roof would be very much appreciated.
