Zion roots run 118 years deep.

Zion Presbyterian began serving meals at the Fair in 1904. We became Zion United in 1925 and carried on. In the 30's Jock Shepherd, Jessie Ann Gamble's grandfather, installed stoves in the Skating Rink where they served Breakfast, Lunch, Afternoon Tea and Dinner.

Now in 2022 we have our Concession Trailer.


**W**ould everyone who took the 'food safe course' please photocopy your certificate when you receive it and give me the copy so that I can send it off to public health.

If you are needing them during the week please try to plan a bit ahead as Eleanor may be away occasionally.


