IPE FLOAT-----100th ANNIVERSARY

This is the 100th Anniversary year of the United Church in Canada.

Did you know? The United Church in Canada is the only religious denomination in Canada formed by an Act of Parliament and the constitution cannot be changed without an Act of Parliament.
