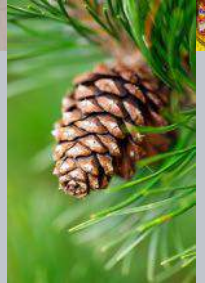


Zion was host to a wonderful afternoon of music to raise funds for flood victims.
