





Sharing the Load





Celebrating 100 years!

On June 10th the United Church of Canada begins its 100th anniversary year. A commemorative book "The Untied Church of Canada" containing written and pictorial accounts of past and present as well as hopes for the future is being published by Wood Lake Books. And yes, it is "Untied"! – unfettered for 2025 celebrations and for the future!

The books are being offered at a group rate as part of the 100th anniversary celebration. The rate for 10 - 24 copies is \$14.95 each, and for more than 25 copies is \$9.95 net of tax and shipping. If you would like to order a copy contact Lorraine Powell or Leona Harrison before June 23.

Just a quick note. St. Andrew's United Church was completed in 1906, the same year that Enderby was declared a city and is celebrating its 118th Anniversary of being a part of Enderby's faith community. The cost of building the church at that time was \$5000 with much of the work done by volunteers.
