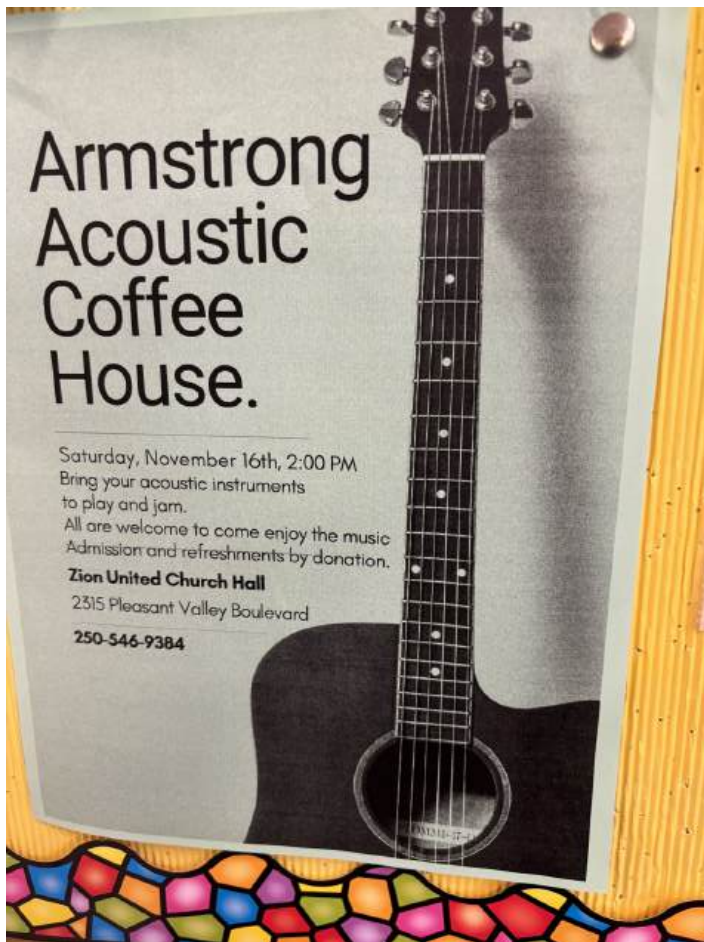

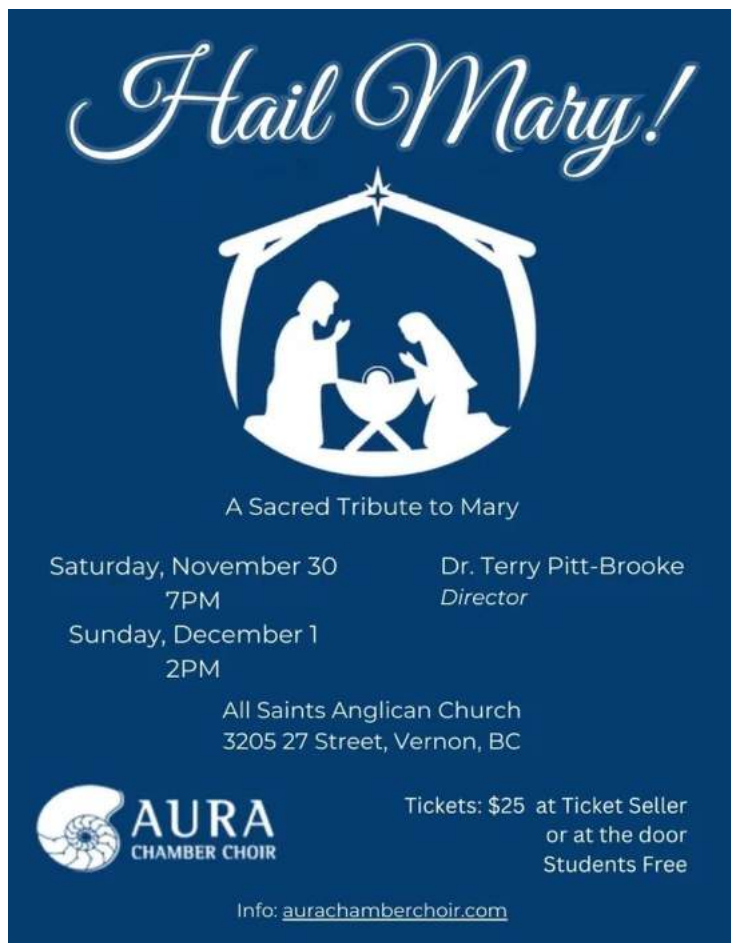

**E**nderby Church Walk takes place on Saturday, December 14 at 6:00 pm. This is a candlelight walk (but you are welcome to drive if you don't want to or can't walk).

It begins at the Enderby Evangelical Chapel, moves to St. Ann's Catholic Church, then to St. George's Anglican Church and finally to St. Andrew's United.

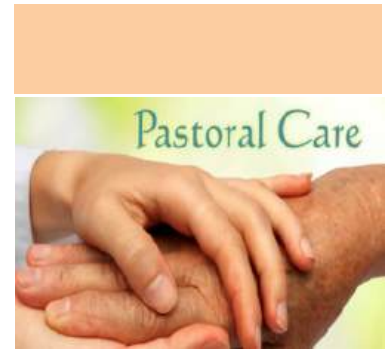
