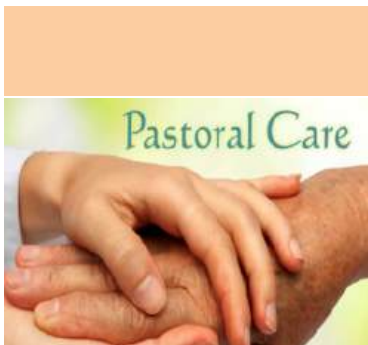
Upcoming events taking place in the advent season


