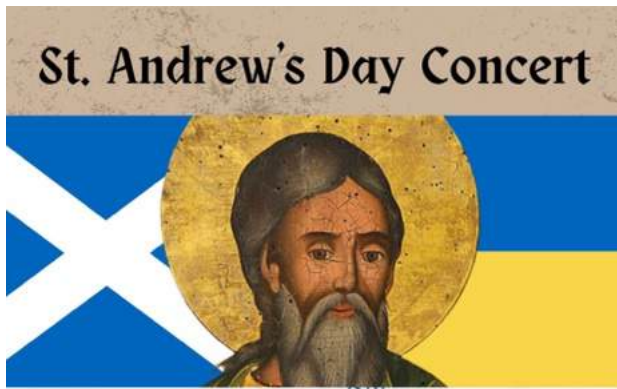
My grandson, Josh is graduating this year and this is a fundraiser for their Dry Grad.
