This is a free, family-friendly event and all are welcome. If you'd like to perform, please talk to Lindsay. The more the merrier!


### The Annual Enderby Church Walk will be Saturday, December 14 at 6 pm.

 Once again we may be asked to help....sweets and cleanup.


**BLUE XMAS SERVICE will be a JOINT SERVICE** at Saint Andrew's on **December 11 at 6:30 pm.**


