Zion Finance Update as of September 30, 2024

Part 1: Church Operations:

Total YTD Operating Income \$67,861 (**\$1,594 less than 2023**)

Total YTD Operating Expenses \$73,693 (**\$2,128 higher than 2023**)

Year to date Deficit (\$5,933) vs. YTD budgeted (\$14,257)

Our YTD deficit is \$3,722 bigger than September 2023, but over \$8,000 less than budgeted. After paying the \$7,536 annual insurance premium this week **we project the 2024 deficit will be (\$15,000)**.

Part 2: Building Fund:

Building Fund Balance January 1 2024 (**\$6,427.96**)

Total YTD Revenue \$3,560.38

Total YTD Building Upgrades \$1,316.02

Building Fund Balance Sept 30 2024 (**\$4,183.60**)


