



***A BASIC GUIDE TO NAMES**

listed below are the First Nations Peoples as they are generally known, with a previous guide to a common pronunciation, somewhere in these phonetic pronunciations may still find a huge gap between what they mean and what they were a native speaker saying. The best way to learn these names is to hear them spoken, either in the presence of someone native (preferably), and perhaps even one for a native lesson. Also included here are some of the more common First Nations groups, and the language families to which they belong.
