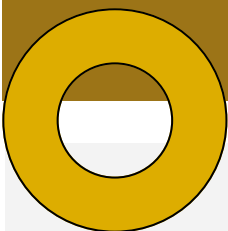

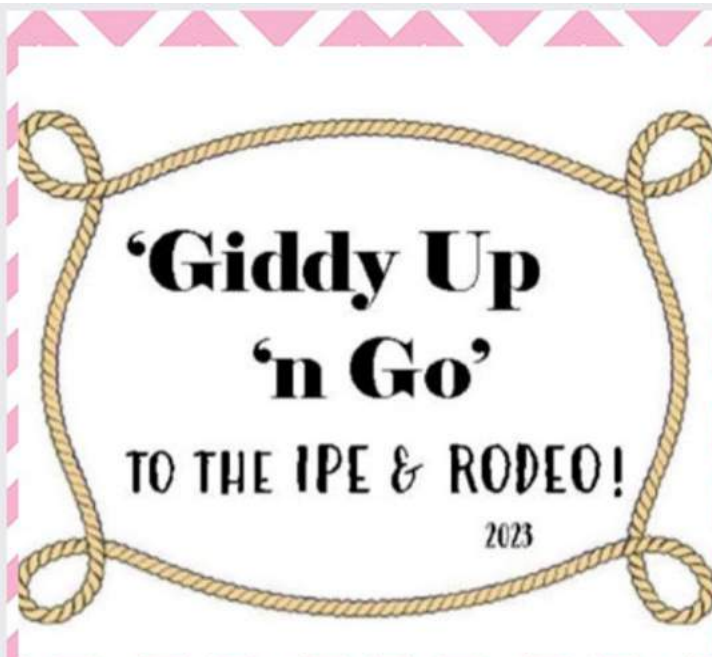
A massive THANK YOU to the approximately 50 volunteers
