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## Patient Instructions Pre-op

### Eleven (11) days prior to procedure:

Avoid taking the following medications:

- Aspirin
- Aleve
- Motrin
- Ibuprofen

#### Two (2) days prior to procedure:

Take Tylenol 650mg by mouth

#### One (1) day prior to procedure:

Take Tylenol 650mg by mouth

Day of procedure:	
<b>60</b> minutes prior to procedure take only if checked	and Rx provided
Two (2) Oxycodone/Acetaminophen 5/325mg One (1) Diazepam 2mg	9
One (1) Promethazine 25mg One (1) Zofran 4mg	

# Patient Instructions Post-op

\*Remember do not blow your nose or resume CPAP machine (if applicable) until we see you after your procedure

Start antibiotics and Prednisone when you get home from your procedure (If provided). If you are provided pain medication and develop nausea you have also been provided with Zofran to use Q8 hours as needed.

\*Do not mix medications we provided you with any other respiratory depressants, such as anti-anxiety medications and/or sleeping pills prescribed by other providers. Examples include Xanax, Valium, Klonopin, Ativan, Ambien, Temazepam, etc. Do not take these respiratory depressants for 48 hours post procedure.
