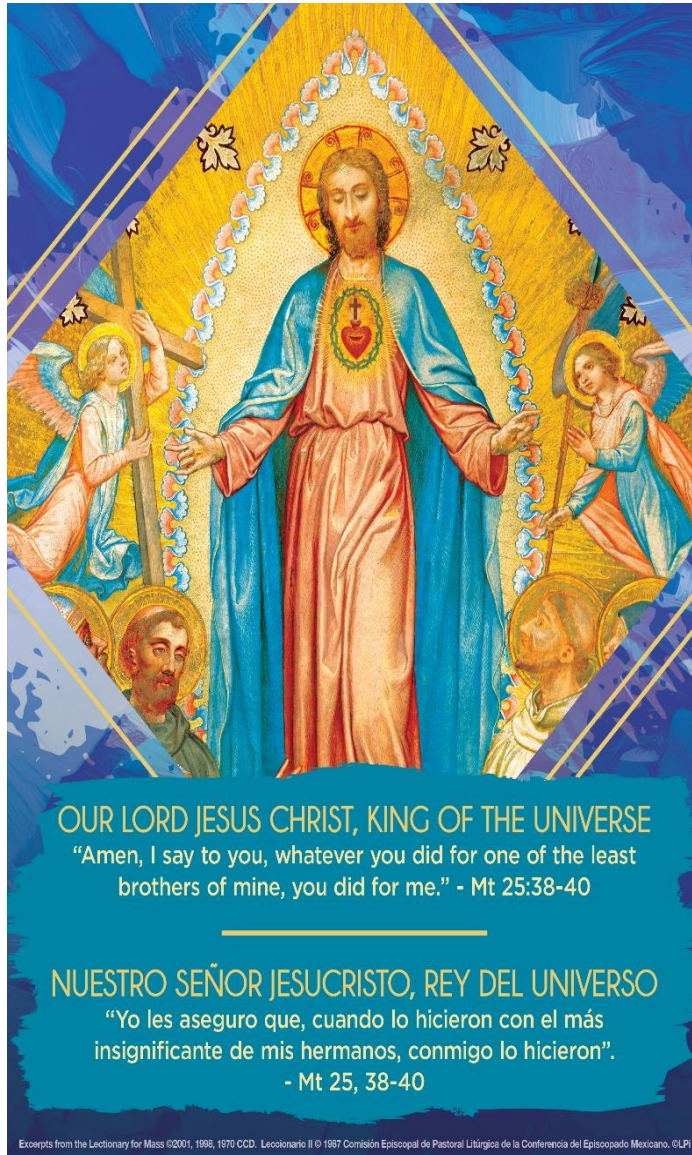

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE

In the 1900's many governments were seeking to push God out of people's lives. The Constitution of 1917 in Mexico instituted anticlerical laws. The laws were slowly enforced starting in 1922, and little by little, the government worked to strip the faith away from the people. Processions and feast days, like Eucharistic Adoration, celebration of Virgen de Guadalupe, and Santo Nino de Atocha, were eliminated. The church was no longer allowed to own property. The government, instead of the bishop, controlled where the priests were assigned. The people tried boycotts and signed a petition with 2 million signatures, to no avail. Eventually, the government forbade the public practice of Catholicism. This injustice led to the creation of the Cristeros, those who defended God and their faith.

José Luis Sanchez del Rio "Josélito," was born March 28, 1913, in Sahuayo, Michoacán, Mexico. José loved his faith and grew up with a strong devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe. When José was twelve years old, he wanted to join the Cristeros but was not allowed. After much pleading, José was allowed to join, but only to clean rifles, prepare the fire, and eventually become a flagbearer. During a battle, José was captured, taken to the town, and tortured. His godfather, Rafael Picazo was the mayor, and the townspeople thought Picazo would save his godson. José turned down every offer his godfather brought to him because, in each instance, it entailed denouncing his faith in some way or another.

Ultimately, Picazo sentenced his godson to death. José was taken from the prison, and the soles of his feet were sliced, and he was forced to walk to the cemetery for his execution. The cemetery was several blocks away, and his bloody footsteps could be seen. He called out "Viva Cristo Rey, Viva Virgen de Guadalupe" along the way. Arriving at the cemetery and standing at the edge of the empty grave, the soldiers gave him one last chance to save his own life. Seeking to hear long live the State, they taunted him with "Who lives." "If you shout, 'death to Christ the King, we will spare you.'" Instead, José called out, "Viva Cristo Rey! Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe!" Angered by his cry for Christ, the soldiers stabbed him repeatedly until the commanding officer shot him in the head.

José was only 14 when he was martyred; he said, "My faith is not for sale," My faith in Christ cannot be sold, even though I know that this involves torture and death." Through it all he remained faithful. St José was canonized on October 16, 2016. Cardinal Francisco Robles Ortega, the Archbishop of Guadalajara encouraged the people to "look at the testimony of a young man, born into an ordinary Christian family, but who had the courage to discover Christ and to be faithful to Him." May we live our love for Christ the King as vibrantly as St. José.

Dear Lord, help me to be courageous and steadfast in my devotion to you. Help me to identify causes and injustices in my day that are worth defending and standing up for. NUESTRO SEÑOR JESUCRISTO, REY DEL UNIVERSO

En los años 1900, muchos gobiernos buscaban expulsar a Dios de la vida de las personas. La Constitución de 1917 en México instituyó leyes anticlericales. A partir de 1922, las leyes se fueron haciendo cumplir lentamente, y poco a poco el gobierno trabajó para despojar a la gente de la fe. Se eliminaron procesiones y días festivos, como la Adoración Eucarística, la celebración de la Virgen de Guadalupe y el Santo Niño de Atocha. A la iglesia ya no se le permitía poseer propiedades. El gobierno, en lugar del obispo, controlaba dónde se asignaban los sacerdotes. La gente intentó boicotear y firmó una petición con 2 millones de firmas, sin éxito. Finalmente, el gobierno prohibió la práctica pública del catolicismo. Esta injusticia llevó a la creación de los Cristeros, aquellos que defendían a Dios y su fe.

José Luis Sánchez del Río “Josélito” nació el 28 de marzo de 1913 en Sahuayo, Michoacán, México. José amaba su fe y creció con una fuerte devoción a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Cuando José tenía doce años quiso unirse a los cristeros pero no se lo permitieron. Después de muchas súplicas, a José se le permitió unirse, pero sólo para limpiar los rifles, preparar el fuego y, finalmente, convertirse en abanderado. Durante una batalla, José fue capturado, llevado al pueblo y torturado. Su padrino, Rafael Picazo, era el alcalde, y la gente del pueblo pensó que Picazo salvaría a su ahijado. José rechazó todas las ofertas que le hizo su padrino porque, en cada caso, implicaban denunciar su fe de una forma u otra.

Al final, Picazo condenó a muerte a su ahijado. A José lo sacaron de la prisión, le cortaron las plantas de los pies y lo obligaron a caminar hasta el cementerio para su ejecución. El cementerio estaba a varias cuadras y se podían ver sus pasos ensangrentados. Gritó “Viva Cristo Rey, Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe” en el camino. Al llegar al cementerio y pararse al borde de la tumba vacía, los soldados le dieron una última oportunidad para salvar su propia vida. Buscando escuchar viva el Estado, se burlaron de él con “Quien vive”. “Si gritas 'muerte a Cristo Rey, te perdonaremos'”. En cambio, José gritó: “¡Viva Cristo Rey! ¡Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe!” Enojados por su grito a Cristo, los soldados lo apuñalaron repetidamente hasta que el oficial al mando le disparó en la cabeza.

José tenía sólo 14 años cuando fue martirizado; dijo: “Mi fe no se puede vender”, mi fe en Cristo no se puede vender, aunque sé que esto implica tortura y muerte. Permaneció fiel a su fe a pesar de todo. San José fue canonizado el 16 de octubre de 2016. El cardenal Francisco Robles Ortega, arzobispo de Guadalajara, animó al pueblo a “mirar el testimonio de un joven, nacido en una familia cristiana común y corriente, pero que tuvo el coraje de descubrir a Cristo y de serle fiel”. Que vivamos nuestro amor por Cristo Rey tan vibrantemente como San José.
