The Day Bewdley's Bear Escaped...

Bewdlev is known for its Georgian charm, riverside strolls. and would you believe a rather unusual animal escape that's still whispered about by locals. Back in the late 1980s, the tranquillity of this Worcestershire town was turned upside down when a bear reportedly broke loose from the West Midlands Safari Park.

It wasn't long before local headlines read like something out of a far-fetched children's story: "Bear on the Loose in Bewdlev!" For days, townsfolk kept a curious eye on the hedgerows while schools whispered about lockdown drills (although, truthfully, the bear was found swiftly. more puzzled than dangerous). To this day, some locals still joke about spotting "the Bewdley Bear" on misty mornings.



The Curious Case of the Leaping Stones...

Over in Stourport-on-Severn. there's an old bit of riverside lore involving the 'leaping stones' a cluster of worn rocks in the Severn that, according to legend, were used by smugglers to cross the river under moonlight. The tale goes that if you leap across them at midnight during a full moon, you'll be blessed with good fortune (or a wet pair of socks, depending on vour aim).

Did You Know?...

The Wyre Forest, one of the largest ancient woodlands in Britain. was once a designated royal hunting ground, reserved for the monarchy and noble elite. Rich in oak. ash, and hornbeam, it provided not only a source of timber and game but also a secluded escape from courtly life.

Local legend suggests that King Charles II. known for his charm and numerous romantic entanglements, would sometimes slip away from Whitehall and visit a secluded glade near Button Oak to secretly rendezvous with one of his mistresses. While official records remain silent on the matter. oral history passed down through generations hints at this royal affair deep in the woods.

To add to the intrigue, some say there's an old tree—gnarled with age and thick with moss—that bears a faint, time-worn carving: the initials "C.R." (Carolus Rex), supposedly etched by the King himself. Though many have searched, the precise location of the tree remains elusive, hidden among miles of twisting trails and shaded paths.

Whether it's truth or tall tale, the story remains a beloved piece of local lore. So, next time vou're wandering near Button Oak, keep your eyes peeled. You never know when you might stumble upon a royal secret lost to time...

One of the biggest hot topics is the endless illegal migrant boats crossing the English Channel. And in July, we saw this dismal government have a go at dealing with the problem.

President Macron's visit gave the opportunity to strike a landmark deal with France. And the result? A "one in: one out" arrangement where we can swap illegal migrants for legal ones. The maths of this means that fully 94% of illegal migrants will stay in the UK. The new government has an appalling record on this. Their first act (on illegal migration) was to axe the Rwanda scheme. This was set up as a deterrent and before it even came into action, it was driving down migrant numbers. Even the

Irish agreed, as they started to

see illegal migration across the border from Norther Ireland as illegal migrants sought sanctuary from potentially being deported to Africa.

Since axing the scheme, illegal migrant arrivals have ballooned, the trade being delighted that Labour's confused approach to tackling the problem emboldened migrants.

Labour's alternative policy - "smashing the gangs" - has failed for blindingly obvious reasons. Smash a gang, and it creates an opportunity for other gangs to fill the newly created void. And it's a simple business model. For up to \$10,000, a migrant will get delivered to the beaches in Kent, where they will be offered free

three-star accommodation for as long as it takes for the free lawyers to come up with a plausible argument for them to claim asylum.

Then they get a council house, a job, and free access to our benefits system and health services. What's not to like?

I did hear a suggestion that whilst failed asylum seekers will get sent back, successful ones should be billed for the costs of access, in a way that every student with a student loan is familiar with. With costs running up to the hundreds of thousands of pounds for each migrant, it seems a reasonable proposal on first inspection, and will certainly make them think twice before coming to the UK. The government has to get a grip on this. It is tackling huge unproductive costs in areas such as welfare and benefits. To be throwing money we simply cannot afford at a problem we can solve is ludicrous. And for many people across the country, it is the unfairness that hurts the most.

History: Stourport: The Canal Town That Changed Everything

While Bewdley was once the region's bustling river port, it was Stourport-on-Severn — a town that barely existed before 1770 — that would become one of the most unique and ambitious transport hubs in Georgian England.

Unlike many neighbouring towns that evolved slowly over centuries, Stourport was built almost overnight. It was designed with a purpose, born from the vision of pioneering engineer James Brindley and the rapid rise of canal transport during the Industrial Revolution. With the construction of the Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal, this quiet riverside location was transformed into a critical junction — where ca-

nal met river, and where goods could flow smoothly across the country.

Between 1770 and 1820, Stourport grew at a remarkable pace. Its population exploded, and with it came rows of handsome Georgian houses, thriving inns, warehouses, boatyards, and five interlinked canal basins. Merchants and labourers flocked to the town, and barges loaded with coal, salt, pottery, sugar, and timber became an everyday sight. It was the very definition of a boom town.

What sets Stourport apart is that it remains one of the only canal towns in the entire country built from scratch to serve this new era of trade and movement. At its height, it rivalled much older and more established towns in both size and economic power. By the early 1800s, more goods passed through Stourport than through Bewdley, despite its centuries of prior trading history.

But like many industrial towns, change came quickly. The arrival of the railway in the 1850s gradually shifted trade away from the canals, and Stourport's importance as a freight hub began to wane. Yet the town adapted. During the late 19th

and early 20th centuries, it reinvented itself as a riverside retreat for day-trippers from Birmingham and the Black Country. Paddle steamers, amusement rides. cafés, and arcades brought joy to thousands. Stourport's spirit of resilience is part of what continues to make it special. The town's story is one of vision, reinvention, and enduring charm. Even today, it maintains a character all its own - a blend of industrial heritage, family-friendly fun, and tranquil waterside living.

Visitors can still stroll beside the original canal basins many beautifully restored and soak in the town's rich industrial heritage. The Tontine Hotel, originally built for canal merchants, still watches over the waterfront, while the locks, towpaths and swing bridges whisper stories of a once-mighty trade route.

Stourport isn't just a picturesque riverside town — it's a living monument to ambition, industry, and ingenuity. A place quite literally built on water, and powered by vision.

Health: The Hidden Danger of Nasal Tanning Sprays: What You Need to Know

n the age of social media and influencer beauty trends, many people-especially younger generations-are constantly seeking fast, effective ways to enhance their appearance. One such trend gaining popularity is the use of nasal tanning sprays: products that promise a deep, bronzed glow without the need for sun exposure or sunbeds. However, melanotan Il is not approved by any major health authority, including the UK's Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) or the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). It is an unregulated, unlicensed substance, and its use comes with serious health concerns.

One of the most significant risks associated with melanotan II is its potential to cause abnormal changes in skin cells, increasing the risk of melanoma, the most serious form of skin cancer. Some users have reported a darkening or change in shape of moles, an indicator that skin cells are reacting to the substance in unpredictable and potentially dangerous ways.

Doctors and dermatologists have been sounding the alarm, urging the public to steer clear of these products. Not only are they untested and unregulated, but the way they are administered—via nasal sprav means the chemicals enter the bloodstream quickly and directly. This bypasses the body's natural filtering systems and increases the chance of side effects. which can include nausea. high blood pressure, facial flushing, increased freckles or moles, and even libido changes.

Despite these risks, nasal tanning sprays have seen a surge in popularity, largely due to their promotion by influencers and online sellers. Platforms like TikTok and Instagram are flooded with before-and-after videos and glowing reviews that fail to mention the lack of safety

testing or regulation. This gives users a false sense of security and normalises the use of potentially harmful substances—all in the name of aesthetics.

The problem is compounded by the fact that these sprays are often marketed directly to young, image-conscious consumers, many of whom may not fully understand the long-term health consequences. With skin cancer rates rising among younger people, experts fear that products like nasal tanning sprays could be contributing to a dangerous trend.

Organisations such as the British Association of Dermatologists and Cancer Research UK have issued public warnings, stating that melanotan II and similar products should be avoided entirely. They urge consumers to opt for safer, regulated alternatives such as topical self-tanning lotions and sprays, which are widely available and have been tested for safety.

It's important to remember that a tan, whether from the sun or a spray, is not a sign of health—it's a response to skin damage. Chasing a certain look at the cost of your long-term health simply isn't worth it. If you're looking for a bronzed appearance, use reputable, approved self-tanners or consider embracing your natural skin tone.

In a world increasingly driven by online trends and instant results, it's easy to be drawn in by the promise of a quick fix. But when it comes to your health, especially something as serious as cancer risk, it's vital to make informed, cautious choices. Don't be misled by viral videos or influencer endorsements—always do your research and consult a medical professional before using any cosmetic product, especially those not approved for use.

Your health is your greatest asset. Treat it that way.

BBQ Recipe: Chicken & halloumi burgers



Ingrediants

2 skinless chicken breasts
1 tbsp oil
4 tbsp piri-piri sauce
or other mild chilli sauce
½ lemon juiced
burger buns split in half
250g block lighter halloumi
sliced into 8 pieces
¾ small white cabbage
finely sliced
2 tbsp mayonnaise
4 tbsp hummus
tzatziki
handful of rocket
2 large roasted red peppers

Method

1. To make the grilled chicken Put the chicken breasts between two pieces of baking parchment and use a rolling pin to gently bash them until they are approximately 1cm thick. Cut each chicken breast into two even pieces.

2. If you're using a frying pan, heat two frying pans over medium-high heat, with one of them containing oil. Fry the chicken in the oiled pan for 3-4 mins on each side until they are cooked through. Season the chicken, reduce the heat, drizzle in the chilli sauce and half of the lemon juice, and cook for an additional 1-2 mins until the sauce is reduced. Remove the chicken from the heat.

3. If you're using an air-fryer, preheat it to 180C for 4 mins. Add the chicken to the air-fryer and cook for 12 mins.

Drizzle over the chilli sauce and half the lemon juice and cook for an additional 1-2 mins until the chicken is cooked through and the sauce is reduced. Remove the chicken and keep it warm.

4. While the chicken is cooking, toast the buns in the dry frying pan for 30 seconds. Transfer them to a plate. If you're using an air fryer, put the buns in the air fryer for 1-2 mins until they are warm. Increase the air fryer temperature to 200C. Add the halloumi to the air fryer basket and cook for 10 mins, turning halfway through, until it's golden. Toss the cabbage with the mayo and the remaining lemon juice.

5. Spoon the hummus (or dip of your choice) into the toasted buns, then top with the rocket, chilli chicken, halloumi, and peppers. Drizzle with a little more chilli sauce, spoon over the cabbage, season with black pepper, and top with the bun lids. Serve with any extra cabbage on the side or a green salad.


