Type of Position: Full-time (30 hours/week)

Dates: Sunday, June 28 – Sunday, August 9 (6 weeks)

Work Days: Sunday – Thursday (Weekends are Friday & Saturday)

Summer Camp Leader Team Responsibilities

To **grow as disciples and leaders** by:

- Wholeheartedly participating in discipleship and leadership activities;
- Meeting regularly with a young adult mentor;
- Participating in other training opportunities (e.g. first aid)

To **work with a team to provide fun, safe children's programs** by:

- Preparing for and participating as a youth leader in weekly Sunday morning children's programs (KidZone)
- Preparing materials and setting up for day camps for children Gr. K-5 (one week of half-day camp and two weeks of full-day camp);
- Leading a station or group of children in KidZone and day camps;
- Debriefing with and cleaning up with the team after day camps.

Qualifications

- Graduated from elementary school before July 1, 2025 (i.e. entering Gr. 10 or higher in September 2026).
- Enthusiasm for the mission and vision of SPL;
- Ready to work within a team;
- Willing to learn.

This position is open to individuals **between the ages of 15 and 30 who are available for full-time work from June 28 to August 9.**
