Thank you for your interest in the Leader in Training Program at Camp-A-Palooza at Kids First Sports Center. This exciting leadership training program, for campers who are 13-15 years of age, is designed to give you hands-on experience in camp counseling, child development, decision-making, community-building, conflict resolution and so much more.

The LIT program is a stepping stone -- learning the skills it takes to be a camp counselor, staff member, or a leader in your home, school, and community. With the program being designed in this way, we will ask more of you than typical campers: more maturity, more time, and more responsibility.

As a first step to the program, we ask that you fill out the enclosed application for the LIT program. It is much like a job application. It will help us to know you a little better, and best capitalize on your skills in camp. Please email your completed application to ashelma@kidsfirstsports.com. After we receive your application, we will email you to set up an interview over zoom in late March/early April. Soon after the interview, we will let you know if you have been accepted into the program for a trial week. More specific details will follow pertaining to weeks, supervision, LIT activities, etc.

We highly encourage that you turn in your application as soon as possible. You can submit your application by emailing it to ashelma@kidsfirstsports.com.

Full participation in the program is not guaranteed after your acceptance. After the first week of leadership development and getting a taste of the LIT program, you will meet with the LIT Coordinator to evaluate your participation in the remainder of the program. (Though, we can reassure you that a camper not being asked to continue the program after the first week is guite rare.)
