This year he has been pivotal in developing position papers, reviewing the MOU and maintaining our commitment to the Wellbeing hub vision. We have attended numerous meetings, written and developed lots of our documents and committed a tremendous amount of valuable time in supporting the Bronllys Well Being Park CLT Ltd.

There have been four position papers that have aided our ongoing development and which have already and hopefully will continue to provide more solutions for our future progress.

We delivered our 3rd excellent Health & Wellbeing Forum event which was extremely well supported and provided the local community the opportunity to voice their thoughts, ask questions and again note their aspirations, needs and wishes. This included the Powys Teaching Health Board CEO Hayley Thomas and our MP David Chadwick.

Regular meetings have taken place with the Health Board including the CEO and a revised MOU was signed together with Powys County Council. Our relationship with the Health Board has been much improved since the change of leadership.

It is evident significant developments are underway in collaboration with the Health Board. Key highlights include:

- 1. *The Chapel Restoration*: Plans to refurbish the Grade II listed chapel are set to begin in 2026, following the appointment of AHR Architects. Community groups will be invited to contribute to the restoration efforts.
- 2. *The Measured Mile Walk*: The park is also focusing on promoting health through initiatives like the "Measured Mile," which encourages walking and physical activity in the community. I will be leading a historical walk around the Bronllys site as part of the Walkers are Welcome event in May 2026.

These projects reflect a commitment to enhancing community wellbeing and preserving local heritage. For ongoing updates, we will continue to share information on these initiatives.
