

- Persecuted Church—Iraq**: Attacks by the self-proclaimed Islamic State (ISIS) forced tens of thousands of Christians to flee the country, leaving a small but bold and faithful remnant. For many of these Iraqi Christians, day-to-day life is focused on survival, and yet they faithfully work to advance the gospel. Many of Iraq's Muslims have rejected Islam and become open to Christ for a variety of reasons. These circumstances provide a unique opportunity to share the gospel with Iraqis searching for hope and truth. The violence and instability have also led to a revival among traditional Christians, many of whom have come to saving faith and become bold witnesses for Christ.
- Unreached People Group—Kachhi (Hindu traditions) in India**: Pray that God would continue to open up doors for the gospel to be shared with the Kachhi.
