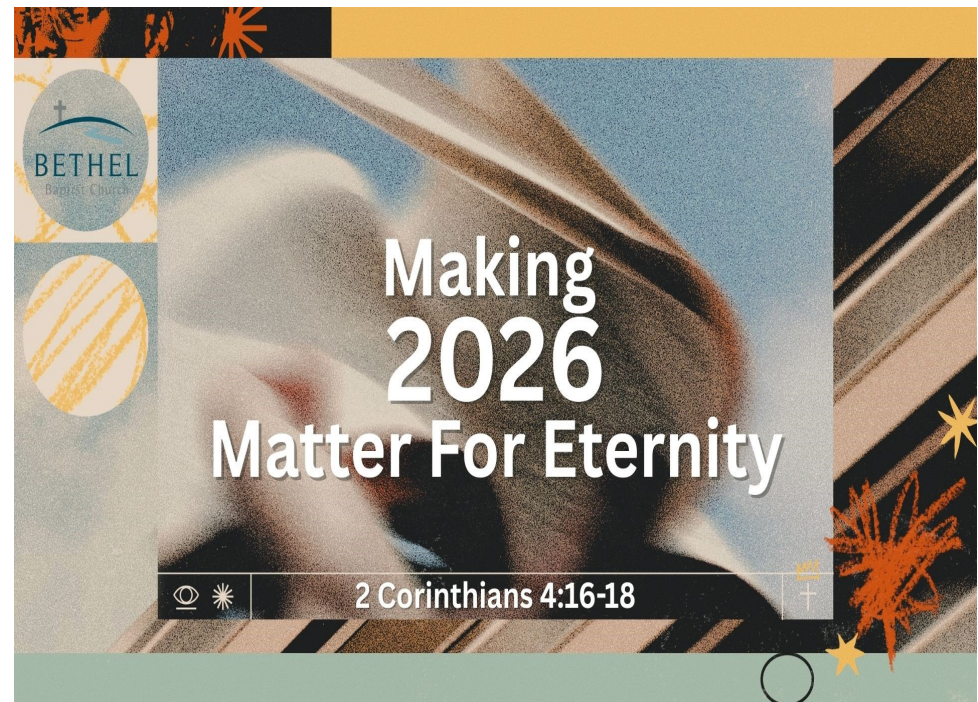

☐ **Persecuted Church—India:** Hindu-nationalist informants live in nearly every village and report on the activities of Christians, resulting in attacks and arrests. When Christians are attacked, they often drop charges against their attackers to show forgiveness as a witness for Christ. Churches have been demolished, burned and shut down, worship gatherings have been disrupted, crosses in graveyards have been vandalized, and Bibles and other Christian literature have been confiscated and burned. Christians are often arrested and detained up to three months after being falsely accused of forcing Hindus to convert to Christianity.



☐ **Unreached People Group—Jat (Sikh traditions) in India:** Ask the Lord to call people who are willing to go to India and Nepal and share Christ with all Sikh Jat communities.

☐ **Church Family**—We pray for those in our congregation and families that are hurting, have recently lost loved ones, or have health concerns.
