❑ **Persecuted Church—Bahrain:** Less than 1 percent of native Bahrainis are Christians; nearly all are Muslims. However, Christians among Bahrain's expatriate workers make up 8 percent of the population. Families and local communities are the main persecutors, but the government occasionally imprisons or harasses a new Christian. Christian converts from Islam often lose their jobs and social status, and many are rejected by their families. However, some still gather to worship in secret.
