Prayer Cards If you would like to support our ministry resident, Weston Jones, through prayer or financial giving, prayer cards with more information are available in the foyer.

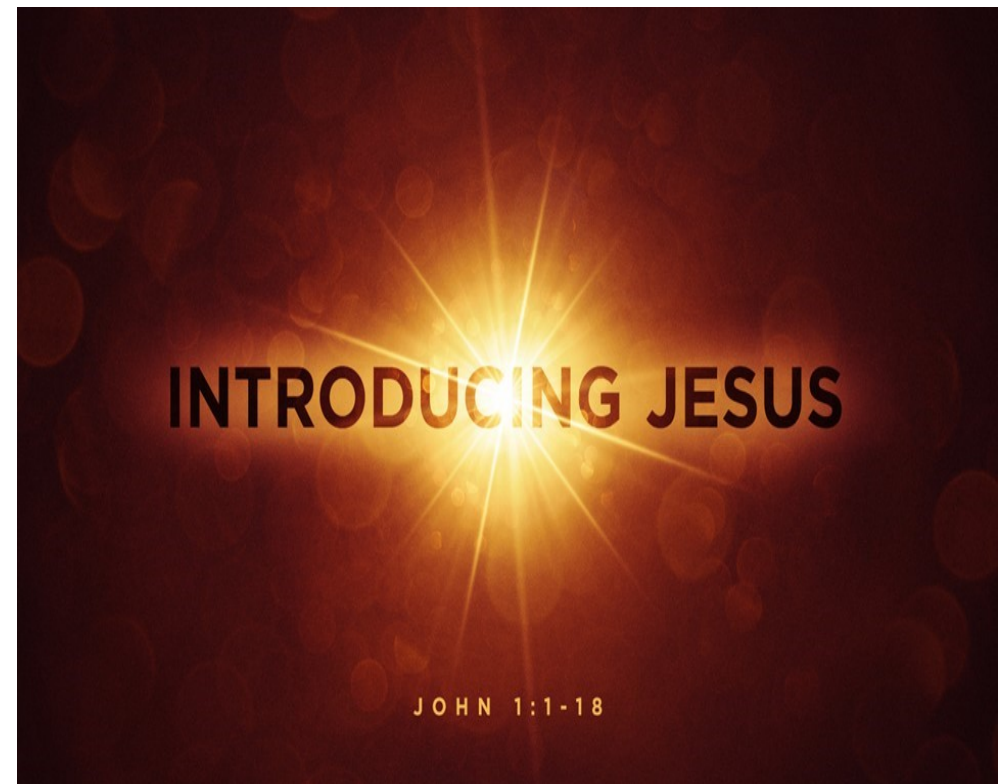
