# *Our History*

Established in the year 1900 by John J. Jennings, in the “undertaking” service in North Scranton, with a livery service of horse drawn carriages. As years passed the services evolved into the Funeral Home, which was located on West Market Street, Scranton. Mary Jennings, FD (John J. Jennings’s daughter) joined the firm in 1947 continuing the operation of the funeral home. She was one of the first female funeral directors to be licensed in the nation. In 1980, Christopher C. Calvey FD, ( great nephew of Mary Jennings ) joined the family practice of Undertaking and operated the Funeral Home on West Market Street, in Scranton, Pennsylvania and branched out to acquire the a Funeral Home in Clarks Summit in the same year, 1980.

The funeral service has evolved from the embalming in the family home, wakes at the corpse house, horse drawn coaches, as well as the services provided by our family of funeral directors. “Corpse house” as many northeastern Pennsylvanians refer to as the visitation at the funeral home stemmed from visiting the home of the deceased with the embalmed body present and visitors expressed sympathy to loved ones.

As the third generation of funeral directors, Christopher C. Calvey after expanding the Funeral Service to Clarks Summit in 1980 and established a Monument business. Jennings – Calvey Funeral and Cremation Services, Inc. provides professional friendly service in a modern facility with state of the art equipment.

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

**BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF .....\$3,100 \_\_\_\_\_**

Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary certificates and permits; shelter of remains; placement of obituary notices; planning of funeral arrangements; and coordination of service with cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding and receiving remains.)

**EMBALMING (Including use of Preparation Room) .....\$995 \_\_\_\_\_**

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, that does not require you to pay for it.

**EMBALMING (Incl. use of Preparation Room) following Autopsy, Tissue Donation, BioHazard ... \$1,100 \_\_\_\_\_**

Pennsylvania Rules and Regulations number 13.201 6(i) requires that any human remains held 24 hours beyond death shall be embalmed or sealed in a container that will not allow fumes or odors to escape or kept under refrigeration, if this does not conflict with a religious belief or medical examination

# Payment Policy

Effective September 1, 2023

## Payment Options

Provisions for payment are due at the time of arrangements. For your convenience, we accept 10 different methods of payment that are listed below. We DO NOT bill estates as they are not processed within our payment terms. The person(s) who pays the funeral bill would invoice the estate for reimbursement of funeral expenses.

- **We accept: Cash, Check, Debit Card, Visa, Master Card and Discover**

- **We accept: Life insurance assignment of a verifiable policy through ClaimCheck**

Due to the unprecedented times of staffing issues, life insurance claims have been taking an average of 30 days to be paid out. Unfortunately, to maintain a positive cash flow position, we cannot accommodate the new normal processing time and ClaimCheck must be used.

- **We accept: Pre-funded Funeral Policies with our funeral home or Pre-funded Burial accounts with a bank.**

- **We accept: Advanced Payment by a Forwarding or Receiving Funeral Home.**
